Accommodation and Transportation

The organisation does not pay travel or lodging expenses for the participating skaters and coaches. Accommodation as well as transportation from and to the ice rink has to be organized by the participant/coaches. However, please feel free to contact our organizing committee with any questions.

Judges and/or Technical specialist

For international entries: please inform the organizing committee in case you are considering adding a judge and/or technical specialist to the competition. If so the KNSB will be informed.

Practice Session

At request there are practice sessions available, for international entries only. Please contact us by mail, claudia@kvhoorn.nl, if you would like to subscribe a skater. Practice sessions are only available by subscription.

Payment is by cash in advance of the practice session at the entrance of the ice rink. Cost € 15,- pro hour, pro skater, with a minimum of 7 skaters and a maximum of 15 skaters on the ice at the same time.

Liability

The organizing committee holds no liability for injuries or damage sustained by competitors during the available practice sessions. In accordance to ISU Regulations, all participants act at their own responsibility. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

Draw

Fair draw of the starting order will be organized at least at the 7th of April 2018 by the computer system of Royal Dutch Skating Association or on the ice rink De Westfries in Hoorn. The starting order and time schedule will be announced on the website after the drawing and by mail to the clubs of the participants.

Time table

Will be made available on the website as soon as possible after the closing date, and send by mail to the competitors. Changes may occur due to technical requirements of the judging system and/or exceeding number of entries.

Registration

Every figure skating club can register in the International Spring-on-Ice Competition 2018. This invitation has been sent to the figure skating federations and clubs in several countries.

All competing skaters will skate a **free program**.

The competition will take place in two days.

The total number of participants can be limited according to the availability of the ice.

Closing date of the registration is the 5th of March 2018 at 23:59 hrs.

Please fill in the official entry form to register.

Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served base.

The organizing club has the right to enter an unlimited number of participants.

No charges for the beneficiary. No cheques will be accepted.

No reimbursement will be made in the case of withdrawing of a skater.

The registration fee has to be paid before the closing date.

Late payments will be handled with an administration fee of € 10,-- pro skater.

The clubs are responsible for the payments via the bank and for transferring the right amount of money.

Judging

The competitors of the categories Starters, Pupillen and Aspiranten will be judged with the score card. See regulations. The competitors of the categories Mini, Midi, Maxi, Pre basic novice (B), Basic Novice (B), Advanced novice (B), Junior (B) and Senior will be judged with the ISU judging (small) system, this judgement will be done without a replay.

Music

Only CD's are accepted (no re-writable CD or mp3).

The recording must be of good quality and the CD labelled clearly with the name of competitor, category and skating club/country abbreviations.

A copy of the CD must be handed in at the accreditation desk anywhere in between arrival up to preferably one hour before the start of the skater's category.

The CD quality cannot be tested beforehand, therefore a second copy should always be available for technical staff in case a technical issue should arise during the competition.

Coaches

Only the coaches who are registered on the registration form will get a batch and will have excess to the ice rink.

For all categories the reference date for the skaters' age is 1st July 2017.

Skaters will be categorised by age and level as much as possible. When the number of skaters in a group has exceeded the organisation can if necessary split up the group by age before the draw.

Prizes

A trophy will be given to all winning competitors.

The protocol will be uploaded on to the homepage immediately after the closing of the competition.

Club members or coaches are allowed to collect trophies that belong to participants that were forced to leave early before completion of the victory ceremony.

	In both spins flying entry is allowed.

Level explanations:

For Pre basic novice, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for level and will be ignored by the technical panel.

Basic novice (warming-up 6 min)

Advanced novices (warming-up 6 min)

Advance novice B (warming-up 5 min)

FS	Girls and Boys
1/6	Max. 6 jump elements (boys 7 jump elements) one of which must be an axel jump. In the 6 jump elements (boys 7 elements) there may be maximum of 2 jump combinations and/or sequences performed. A jump combination may only consist out of 2 jumps. And a jump sequences may consist of more jumps but only the 2 most difficult jumps will be counted. When you perform a jump combination the marks that you will get for the 2 jumps will be added. Only two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 1/2) or more revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. Triples jumps are allowed.

7.	Combination spin with or without change of foot (min 8) flying entry is allowed
8.	Flying spin (min 6) or spin with flying entry in one position with one change of foot (min.8)
9.	Step sequence

Level explanations:

For Advanced novice and Advanced novice B, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 3 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for level and will be ignored by the technical panel.

Junior (warming-up 6 min)

Requirements of the competition conform Junior ISU.

Junior B (warming-up 5 min)

FS	Ladies and men
1/8	Max. 7 jump elements (boys 8 jump elements) one of which must be an axel jump. In the 7 jump elements (boys 8 elements) there may be maximum of 3 jump combinations and/or sequences performed. One jump combination can consist of 3 jumps
9.	Combination spin
10.	Flying spin in one position or spin combination with a flying entrance
11.	Spin in one position
12.	Step sequence

Level explanations:

For junior B, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 4 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for level and will be ignored by the technical panel.

Senior (warming-up 6 min)
