The Nice Baie des Anges Association and the Fédération Française des Sports de Glace are pleased to announce the Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating 2022, an international competition in figure skating for Senior & Junior Competition for Men, Women, Pairs skating and Ice Dance.

The Trophy Metropole Nice Côte d'Azur, as all international ISU calendar competitions will provide athletes opportunities to improve their world standing by addition of points according to ISU rules.

Please note:

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the "Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating 2022 " if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) the decision or recommendation of the national/local Government will not agree to conduct such an event or if the travel restrictions into and out of France will block the Teams for an unexpected period of time.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and b) they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

For the proper conduct of the competition, 130 skaters will be retained.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

2.1 ISU MEMBER :

Fédération Française des Sports de Glace

2.2 DATES:

The competition will be held in Nice, from October 18th to 23th, 2022.

2.3 VENUE:

All competition events and practice sessions will take place in the rink 60 X 30 meters of the Sports Palace Jean Bouin - Esplanade De Lattre de Tassigny - 06000 NICE.

Indoor ice-rink, air conditioned, not heated.

The Ice Rink is located in the city centre of Nice and easily accessible by tram (Stop: Palais des Expositions).

2.4 SENIOR MEN

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pairs, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2 and the respective ISU Communication.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced-Program" and the element values.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/-10 seconds

2.5 SENIOR WOMEN

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2 and the respective ISU Communication.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced-Program" and the element values.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds

2.6 SENIOR PAIR SKATING

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 620, paragraph 1 and 2, for 2022/2023 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 621 and the relevant ISU Communications. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced program" and the element values.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds

2.7 SENIOR ICE DANCE

Rhythm Dance:

In accordance the ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 709, and all pertinent ISU Communications. Rhythms required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 2468, and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds, +/- 10 sec

Free Dance:

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2468 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds

2.8 JUNIOR MEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022* Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2022/23.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

2.9 JUNIOR WOMEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022* Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2022/23.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

2.10 JUNIOR PAIR SKATING

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2022/23.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2022, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

2.11 JUNIOR ICE DANCE

Rhythm Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 709.

Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 2468 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec. +/- 10 sec

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2022, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2468 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 General

All Entries to the **Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating** must be submitted using official forms. The forms have to be sent to the OC by e-mail: evenements@ffsg.org by the published deadlines.

The Entries by names must be made not later than September 18th, 2022 – 20:00 h (local time Nice).

3.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate up to two (2) judges who have at least the qualification "Judge for International Competitions". In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

The panel of judges in each event of the competition will consist between 5-7 judges of different ISU members if possible, but not less than 5 judges, drawn among all nominated judges.

The confirmation of the list of judges will be announced latest September 21st, 2022.

3.3 Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one Coach per Skater will be accredited.

An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Only two Team Officials of each Member, including the Member President provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation, will be accredited.

Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

An accompanying person to a Judge will only be accepted for accreditation if this person is a partner in life or a relative of the Judge.

The Member Federations guarantee that the requested accreditation of Team Members will correspond to their function within the team and the Federation.

3.4 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

- 80.00 € per single skater
- 120.00 € per pair or ice dance couple

The entry fee must be paid by bank transfer no later than: **September 18th, 2022.**

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries.

Notice: All Entry Fee payments received **after September 18th, 2022** are subject to **late entry fee of 10€** per single skater. The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation is substituting a skater, whose entry fee was paid by the deadline by another skater.

4. APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS

This **Trophy Metropole Nice Cote d'Azur of Figure Skating** event will follow the principles of Rule 420, paragraph 5.a) of the ISU Special Regulations Single Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022 for appointing the event officials.

The members of each individual Technical Panel (Technical Controller and the Technical Specialists) will not be from the same ISU Member and will have at least the qualification "International".

The Referee will have at least the qualification "International" and could be of the same ISU Member as one member of the Technical Panel (Technical Controller and Technical Specialists).

The Data Operator and the Replay Operator will have at least the qualification "International".

5. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide one meal (LUNCH **OR** DINNER) for all competitors participating, during the competition and in accordance with travel opportunities before and after the event, if necessary. Each member invited, covers the travel and the hotel (bed and breakfast) for their own competitors.

The expenses for rooms and meals, travel and transfer of the Team Leaders, Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the organizer and are on the account of the Teams.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for travels, rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators participating, beginning with lunch on Tuesday October 18th, 2022, until breakfast on Monday October 24th, 2022.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Judges, beginning with lunch on Tuesday October 18th, 2022, until breakfast on Monday October 24th, 2022.

Should any of them arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and meals will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid by themselves, except if an arrangement has been made with the organizers.

All Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialist, the Data and Replay Operators will receive a pocket money of EUR 150.00

All judges will receive a pocket money of EUR 100.00.

6. PRACTICE

The official practice will start on Wednesday, October 19th, 2022. A detailed schedule will be posted well ahead and will also be handed out at the time of registration.

7. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

7.1 MUSIC

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD in any other approved format, in accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single and Pairs, for the Rhythm and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must be listed for each Competitor on the official Music Selection Form and attached to the official Entry Form for Competitors.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1, all covers/discs must show the Competition event, Competitor's name, the Nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating, rhythm dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate disc.

ISU Member is responsible for submitting their competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee evenements@ffsg.org until October 07th, 2022 (one week prior to competition).

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

- each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format of WAV or MP3 file).

If the music files have been submitted within the above-mentioned deadline to the Organizing Committee, then the music team of the Organizing Committee is entirely responsible for the correct execution of the music. In case of issues with submitted music files the Organizing Committee may request at the time of registration a secondary copy of the music files. In case the music files have not been submitted in time to the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

PLEASE NOTE:

CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single, for the Rhythm and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must all be entered, in detail, by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated form.

All music must be provided to the Organizing Committee in MP3 or M4A format latest by 07th October 2022.

All competitors must be able to provide back-up copies on CD in excellent format on site if requested.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

7.2 PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

The Planned Program Content must be entered by the ISU member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

The ISU Member or the Skater(s) is (are) responsible for submitting their Planned Program Content as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (evenements@ffsq.org) until October 07th, 2022.

16. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

The Organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the Competition.

The best three placed skaters/couples in the final ranking of each category will be asked to take part in an exhibition on Sunday afternoon. Additional skaters/couples will be invited to participate.

Prizes money, earned in competition, are paid by organizers, only for skaters participating at the exhibition which is a part of the competition.
