The Four National Championships will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulation 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

4. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality in advance via email to <u>4NC2024@gmail.com</u> until **December 10, 2023** in accordance with Rules 343, paragraph 2.

Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s). The music files must be provided in MP3 format. Any other format is not acceptable. In addition,



competitors/couples must provide a **back-up drive** (USB-Stick) for each program, fulfilling the same requirements.

The exact running time of the music must be communicated to the OC when submitting the music and shall be certified by the competitor/coach/team leader at the time of registration.

Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the OC.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

It is mandatory that the PPCs must be completed precisely by each skater/couple in English using the terminology listed in the respective ISU Communication.

5. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

The three best placed skaters/couples in each event will be announced at the official Victory Ceremony. Gold, Silver and Bronz medals will be presented to the medallists. The National Anthem of the winner will be played.

The Victory Ceremony for the best three placed skaters/couples of each Nation, as a result of the participating Federations' National Championships, will be organized office by the Federations themselves. 4NC OC will provide the podium.

Team Trophy

The result of the Team Trophy will be done as follows.

- a.) All Four Nations are participating in the 4NC, will participate in the Team Trophy. Only senior categories will count
- b.) Participating events in the Team Trophy on 4NC 2024:
 - a. Men,
 - b. Ladies.
 - c. Pairs
 - d. Ice Dance
- c.) Three categories will be included to the point calculations. The categories will be chosen based on the best two results per category per Nation.
- d.) Each medal and placement in each participating categories has a point value see the table below. These points will be allocated to the Nation.
- e.) The highest points earned by a Nation will win the first place of the Team Trophy, the second highest points earned by a Nation will win the second place of the Team Trophy and the third highest points earned by a Nation will win the third place of the Team Trophy.
- f.) In case the earned points will match, the total score of the best two results in three categories per country decides who will win the Team Trophy Placement.



g.) The three best Nations will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony.

Reimbursement for travel, lodging and per diem for Referees, Technical Panel, Judges, Athletes and Coaches shall be determined by each participating country according to their own rules and decisions.

The invoices for organizing expenses will be issued after the conclusion of the event.

10. TRANSPORTATION

Official Hotels for Skaters, Team Leaders, Coaches and Team Officials and Venue are within walking distance, no transportation (shuttle bus) is organized.

The **shuttle** will be provided **to the Opening Ceremony** from all three hotels and back and also for Judges and other Event Officials between the Hotel & Zamek Svijany and the ice rink Ludvika Koska Turnov upon the training and competition schedule.

The exact times of the transportation will be announced in due time.

There will be no pick up service at the airports, bus or train stations.
