JURY COMPOSITION

For each category, the jury is made up of a technical panel (1 Technical Controller, 2 Technical Specialists and 2 Data Video Replay Operators) and a panel of judges comprising 1 Referee and a minimum of 5 Judges.

Each participating country (other than France) may nominate a judge preferably from the ISU list for the 2024/2025 season.

The first meeting of Refereeing Officials will take place at the Ice Rink on **Saturday, February 15, 2025** at a time determined by the Referee.

The Organizing Committee will cover accommodation, meals and travel expenses for all French judges and French competition officials. For foreign judges appointed by their nation, only accommodation and meal expenses will be covered.

Travel expenses for referees and the Technical Panel are borne by the organizing club.

OFFICIAL TRAINING

Each team will be allocated an official training time as described below. It will be followed for the Juvenile category by the Technical Element, for French teams only: Official training sessions will take place on Saturday mornings according to the draw:

RUNNING ORDER

For each category, the starting order will be determined by drawing lots.
The draw will be carried out by computer after the registration deadline, and will be available on the CSNPAS website and e-mailed to participating teams.

ACCREDITATION-ACCUEIL

All participating teams, officials, referees, judges and competition officials are invited to be accredited upon arrival at the Ice Rink.

A welcome service will be set up at the rink for the duration of the competition, starting **Friday, February 14, 2025, 4:00 p.m.** at the rink.

Each team will receive 1 welcome pack and passes (1 President, 1 Team Manager, 2 Coaches per club and 2 Chaperones per team)..

SCORING SYSTEM AND PROGRAM COMPOSITION

The scoring system is based on the ISU Judging System.

Depending on the category, free program compositions must comply with ISU or national regulations (see ISU and national regulations).

FORM

A Drive link to complete the Forms on the net will be sent from **October 5, 2024** by the CSNPAS to each club pre-registered on the "QUESTIONNAIRE INFOS CLUBS". Forms must be completed by **November 23, 2024**. For Forms 1 to 4, any changes must be requested by e-mail to: **sylvie.coupez@wanadoo.fr**, copy **contact@scco.fr** and **celine.scco@gmail.com** by **February 8, 2025**. After this deadline, changes can only be made at the time of accreditation.

MUSIQUE

All teams must provide in advance their competition music of excellent quality on an MP3 file via we-transfer by e-mail, either directly as an attachment or using a download link no later than **February 1, 2025**, to contact@scco.fr and celine.scco@gmail.com and sylvie.coupez@wanadoo.fr. Each e-mail must contain a single music file or download link. The subject of the e-mail must be in the format "**Category name, program (free) and team name.**"

The volume level of the music as determined by the Medical Commission must not exceed 85-90 Pressure dB Sound Level throughout the rink.

Each team must bring their competition music on a USB key to the competition as a backup. Each USB key must be placed in an envelope bearing the team name, category and exact duration of the music (not skating time).

FORM PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET

The form « PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET » (Form 4) must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by the registration deadline. However, program content may be modified up to the time of accreditation. The modified form must be sent to the Technical Delegate: sylvie.coupez@wanadoo.fr by **February 8, 2025**. After this deadline, Form 4 must be submitted at the time of accreditation. It may not be submitted directly to the refereeing officials.

CLOSING CEREMONY - PODIUMS

All participants are required to be in costume for the announcement of results and presentation of awards.

Teams are expected to participate in the closing ceremony as arranged by the organizing club.

ORGANISATION

The organization of the competition is the responsibility of the Organizing Club, which reserves the right to make any arrangements necessary for the smooth running of the competition.

All decisions relating to such arrangements will be taken in agreement with the Referee.

RIGHT TO IMAGE

All participants in the competition (skaters, accompanying persons, spectators,) authorize the use of their still or moving images, representing them, without any financial compensation.

This right is valid before, during and after the competition.

RESPONSIBILITY

In accordance with ISU rule 119, the Fédération Française des Sports de Glace and the Competition Organizing Committee cannot be held responsible for any injury or damage to competitors or officials.

A medical service will be set up by the Organizing Committee throughout the competition and training sessions to provide emergency medical care at the competition venue.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Team Managers must be able to provide each skater with the medical information required in the event of an emergency or accident.

This information should include, but not be limited to, the following, to assist medical personnel:

- Allergies
- Existing illnesses (asthma, ...)
- Current treatments and medications
- Vaccination record
- Blood group
- Use of glasses, contact lenses, dental appliances
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AWARDS

The top three teams in each category receive an award.
Each competitor receives a souvenir.

ANTI DOPING

Anti-doping tests may be carried out in accordance with current ISU anti-doping rules and procedures (ISU communications No. 2366 and 2568 or any new updates to these communications). No skater is permitted to consume alcohol during the competition.

EXTRA PRACTICE

It is possible to book extra practices. The organizing club "S.C.C.O." will send a booking form to each club that has requested it via Form 5. Any special requests should be addressed to: contact@scco.fr and celine.scco@gmail.com, sylvie.coupez@wanadoo.fr. Payment should be made within 3 weeks of the competition. Everything will be managed by the S.C.C.O.
