The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the ISU and is opened to all eligible Team Skaters according to the ISU Rules 102.

The results will be calculated according to ISU Rules.

Jokers Rules :

The rule states that jokers should be either 2 years older or 2 years younger than the age limit.

Example : Junior : 12 years to less than 19 years, jokers may be 10 years to less than 21 years.

The joker can be used only when the minimum number of skaters is reached.

If the team uses jokers, the number of alternates will be proportional to the number of wild cards as follows:

- 0 joker = 4 substitutes age category
- 1 joker = 3 substitutes age category
- 2 joker = 2 substitutes age category

**** Rule of 80% and 20% :**

For senior and junior categories, the rule of 80% / 20% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

100% of the skaters:

- At least 80% must meet the age category
- 20% or less may be outside the age criteria of the category.

6) JUDGING SYSTEM AND PROGRAMS ELEMENTS

The judging system is the new judging system.

The short program of senior championship and junior championship categories must be executed according of the ISU Rules.

The free program of senior championship, senior, junior championship , junior, novice advance and novice basic categories must be executed according of the ISU Rules.

The short and free programs must at least contain the following compulsory items

7) PANEL OF JUDGES

The panel of Judges is composed for each category of :

Each participant country may enter one international judge on synchronized skating from the official ISU list of judges for the season 2010/2011.

The first judges meeting will be hold on Saturday February 26, 2010 in the morning at the ice rink.

The accommodation and travel fees will be supported by the organizing committee for all the judges, technical specialists and accountants of the competition. Concerning the foreign judges, only the accommodation fees will be taken into account.

Travel expenses for the Referees and Technical Panel will be taken in charge by the organizing committee.

9) OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Each team will be allocated a twelve (12) minutes practice session for free program and a ten (10) minutes practice session for short program.

10) STARTING ORDER

For each category, the starting order will be determined by draw, on alphabetical order of countries.

The draw will be made by the Referee in accordance with ISU regulations.

11) PRIZES-AWARDS

The first three teams in each category will receive a cup.

Each competitor will receive a souvenir in each category

12) CLOSING CEREMONY - PODIUMS

All participants must be present on ice in their competition costumes for the announcement of the result and for the prize awarding ceremony.

All participants must be part of the closing ceremony and follow the organization decided by the Organization Committee.

13) ORGANISATION

The organization of the competition is the responsibility of the BSG. It reserves the right to take any measures necessary to ensure that the competition runs smoothly.

All decisions concerning such measures will be taken with the agreement of the Referee.

14) LIABILITY

According to the ISU Rule 119, the Organizing Committee for the "Bordeaux Aquitaine Trophy" accepts no liability for injuries or damages sustained by competitors or officials.

A medical service will be on duty at the ice rink during all the time of the competition

15) DOPING

An anti-doping control can take place according to the regulations of the Ministry of Sport.

16) REGISTRATION

Every participating team, Officials, Referees, Judges, Technical Specialists and Accountants are invited to register upon arrival at the ice skating rink.

A welcoming desk will be in place at the Ice Rink, during all the time of the competition, starting on Friday February, 25th 2011, 4:00 a.p.

Every team will receive 3 reception files and 5 passes (1 president, 1 coach , 1 team manager and 2 chaperons,)
