3. Entries

The organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the competition. In accordance with ISU General Regulations 2010, Rule 119, the organizers may not be held responsible for eventual accidents or other damages to participants, officials or third parties.

8. Music

Music will be reproduced from a CD-player. CD's must be handed over to the organizer immediately at the registration.

9. Calculation of results

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating 2010, Rule 352, will be in place in all categories.

10. Awards

The three best competitors of each event will be awarded with cups. All other competitors will receive a gift.

11. Opening draw

The opening draw will take place at 09:00 A.M. on Saturday, March, 19th 2011 at the restaurant of the ice rink.
