1. General regulations

The Belgrade Trophy 2011 figure skating competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2010, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2010, the relevant ISU Communications and Serbian Skating Association Technical Regulations for juvenile, per-junvenile and interpretative competitions.

Participation in the **Belgrade Trophy 2011** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 1420 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 1420 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

2. Entries

Charges:

30 € (EUR) have to be paid for each competitor at the registration before the competition.

Expenses:

The Organizer will provide and cover the the expenses of competition, awards and presents. Competitors, Coaches and Team Leaders have to bear their own expenses. The Panel of Judges will consist of ISU, International and National Judges and National Technical Specialist and Controller from Serbia.

Responsibility:

In accordance with ISU Regulations, rule 119, all participants, officials and volunteers act at their own responsibility. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

Music:

Music will be reproduced from a CD-player. CD's must have the full name of the competitor, club and category in which the competitor is entered. CD's must be handed over to the organizer immediately after the arrival of the teams.

Calculation of results:

The results will be calculated in accordance with ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules 2010 Single and Pair Skating 2010 – Rules 352 and 353 **(ISU Judging System)**.

Planned Program Content Sheet:

It is mandatory that the form "Planned Program Content Sheet" must be filled in for each skater of each category in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. This form must reach the organizer at latest March 25, 2011 by e-mail belgradeskate@gmail.com.

3.1 SENIOR

Age Requirements: according to ISU Constitution and General Regulations

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010, Rule 511, paragraphs 1 and 3, for season 2010/11 and the respective ISU Communications.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec. maximum, but may be less

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010, Rule 512 and the respective ISU Communications.

Duration:

Men: 4 min., 30 sec., (+/- 10 sec.)

Ladies: 4 min., (+/- 10 sec.)

3.2 JUNIOR

MEN / LADIES

Age Requirements: according to ISU Constitution and General Regulations

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010, Rule 511, paragraphs 1 and 3, for season 2010/11 and the respective ISU Communications.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec. maximum, but may be less

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010, Rule 512 and the respective ISU Communications.

Duration:

Men: 4 min., (+/- 10 sec.)

Ladies: 3 min., 30 sec., (+/- 10 sec.)

3.3. NOVICE ADVANCED (Mladi juniori)

BOYS / GIRLS

Age requirements: Has reached at least the age of ten (10) before July 1st preceding the event, and has not reached the age of fifteen (15) for Girls and Boys in singles competitions.

Competition will be held in accordance with ISU Communication No. 1649

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are listed in ISU Communication No. 1649.

Duration: 2 min., 30 sec., maximum but it may be less

Free Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communications No. 1649.

Duration:

Boys: 3 min., 30 sec., (+/- 10 sec.)

Girls: 3 min., (+/- 10 sec.)

3.4 BASIC NOVICE „A“ (Kadeti “A”)

BOYS / GIRLS

Age requirements: Has reached at least the age of ten (10) before July 1st preceding the event, and has not reached the age of thirteen (13) for Girls and Boys in singles competitions.

Only Free Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communications No.1649 “Guidelines for Novice Competitions”

Duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min., 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec.)

A well balanced program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jumps elements for Girls and Boys one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Triple jumps are not permitted.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total).
- c) There must be a maximum:
 - (i) for Girls one (1) step sequence or one (1) spiral sequence consisting of max. two (2) spiral positions. The sequence (step or spiral) will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
 - (ii) for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The Factor of the Program Components is 2.5.

Levels explanations:

For Basic Novice A Singles, in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

3.5 JUVENILE (Kadeti “B”)

BOYS / GIRLS

Age requirements: Has not reached the age of ten (10) before July 1st preceding the event, for Girls and Boys in singles competitions.

Only Free Skating:

Duration:

Boys: 2 min., 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec.)

Girls: 2 min. (+/- 10 sec.)

A well balanced Free Skating program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Any single or double jump can be repeated only once, either in jump combination or in a jump sequence.
- b) Max. 2 spins, one of which must be a spin combination (with or without change of foot) and one spin with only one position, with or without change of foot. Minimum of six (6) revolutions in both spins in total.
- c) 1 step sequence or spiral sequence must fully utilize the ice surface.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The Factor of the Program Components is 2.5.

Levels explanations:

For Juvenile (Kadeti “B”) Singles, in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

3.6 PRE – JUVENILE / Kadeti “C”

BOYS / GIRLS

Age requirements: Has not reached the age of eight (8) before July 1st preceding the event, for Girls and Boys in singles competitions.

Only Free Skating:

Duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min. (+/- 10 sec.)

A well balanced Free Skating program must contain:

- a) max. 4 jump elements, which may contain max. 2 jump combinations or sequences.
Only 2 jumps can be executed 2 times.
- b) max. 2 spins of a different nature with minimum of three (3) revolutions in total.

- c) 1 step sequence or spiral sequence with utilize $\frac{1}{2}$ of the ice surface.
- d) 1 spiral sequence with utilize $\frac{1}{2}$ of the ice surface.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The Factor of the Program Components is 2.5.

Levels explanations:

For Pre – Juvenile (Kadeti “C”) Singles, in all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

3.7 INTERPRETATIVE „A“

Age requirements: Has reached at least the age of fifteen (15) before July 1st preceding the event, for Girls and Boys in singles competitions.

Free program:

Duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min., 30 sec. (+/- 10 sec.)

In the program are allowed 5 jumps, which may contain max. 1 jump combination, jumps can not be repeated.

3.8 INTERPRETATIVE „B“

Age requirements: Has reached at least the age of twelve (12) before July 1st preceding the event, and has not reached the age of fifteen (15) for Girls and Boys in singles competitions.

Free program:

Duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min. (+/- 10 sec.)

In the program are allowed only 4 single jumps, combinations are not allowed, jumps can not be repeated.

3.9 INTERPRETATIVE „C“

Age requirements: Has not reached the age of twelve (12) before July 1st preceding the event, for Girls and Boys in singles competitions.

Free program:

Duration:

Boys and Girls: 2 min. (+/- 10 sec.)

In the program are allowed only 3 single jumps, combinations are not allowed, jumps can not be repeated.

For athletes in Interpretative category is allowed as following:

Music: no limits, accepted the vocal.

Costums: according to the interpretation of the music-theme.

Objects: allowed if not dangerous for the ice.

Judges panels and scores – evaluated as following:

- judge artistic and technical value: jumps, spins, steps, spirals, skating;
- judge coreography value: interpretation, posture, presentation, originality

Final result: majority position; in case of equal position, the best result in the interpretative value wins.

Calculation of results for Interpretative A, B i C is OBO System.
