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ALEVIN for Girls and Boys

(Have not reached 12 years of age before July 1st of the current season)

- Max. 4 jump elements (Axel is required)
- Max. 2 different spins of a different nature. (Only if they make a CCoSp, this will be able to opt at level 4, the rest they will never obtain more of level 2)
- Max. 2 jump combinations or sequences, only one may consist of three jumps
- Maximum one choreographic step sequence or one choreographic camel sequence

Program: **2'30" +/- 10"**

The falls will discount 0.5 points

MINIMA for Girls and Boys

(Has not reached the age of 13 before July 1st of the current season)

- Max. 5 jump elements (Axel is required)
- Max. 2 different spins (Only if they make a CCoSp, this will be able to opt at level 4, the rest they will never obtain more of level 2)
- Max. 3 jump combinations or sequences, only one may consist of three jumps
- Maximum one choreographic step sequence or one choreographic camel sequence

Program: **3min. +/- 10**

The falls will discount 0.5 points

Note for Alevi and Minima:

* Only three components of program will be punctuated: Skating Skills, Performance and Interpretation.

* The half Lop passes to being listed element will be named as Lo, therefore a sequence of jump formed by 1A+2S SEQ, will pass to be 1A+1Lo+2S and a combination of jump, formed by three jumps, will be considered instead of.
