All ISU Members and all Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category. However, the Organizer shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited clubs.

ENTRY FEE

Single Skating with one program:	65€
Single Skating with two programs:	75€
Ice Dance all categories (per pair):	90€

Each club has to pay for its participants 50% of the total amount right after the entry form confirmation, by **October 28, 2013**. The rest fee has to be paid at accreditation before the competition (**Cash Only**).

In case of cancellation the competitor has to inform the Organiser not later than three weeks before the competition starts. The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 50% pre-payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the ice rink. The time will be announced later.

MUSIC

Music must be recorded on CD-s and submitted at the time of accreditation. The music Medias must be of good quality and labeled clearly with the Competitor's name, Nation, category and the exact music time. Each program must be recorded on a separate disc. All CD-s will be returned to the team leader by the end of the competition at the ice rink.

ACCOMMODATION

The official hotel of the competition is *Go Hotel Shnelli*, located next to the medieval old town of Tallinn and a few steps away from the city centre. There is a convenient public transport connection between the hotel and the Ice

Arena (a 20-minute ride, with a trolley stop right next to the hotel).

All participants have to book and pay the accommodation by themselves.

AWARDING

All competitors will receive a diploma and a present.

The three best competitors of the Tallinn Championships will be awarded with medals and diplomas.

PROTESTS

Protests based on alleged violation of Rules may be lodged provided that they are not forbidden by this or another Rule (Rule 123, para 4. i), ii)). Protests must be filed with the Referee in writing and within the stated time limit (Rule 123, para 3). At the same time 50 EUR or other convertible currency to the same value must be deposited with the Referee.

RESULTS

The results for Ice Dance and Single skating: Senior, Junior, Advanced Novice, Basic Novice A, Basic Novice B will be calculated according to ISU Regulations. Chicks and Cubs will be calculated according to Estonian Figure Skating Classification for season 2013/2014 (Annex #2).

LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the Organizer accepts no liability for injury, property loss or damages incurred by Competitors or Officials. The Organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.
