The 2025 Blackburn Trophy International Solo Ice Dance Competitions will be conducted in accordance with the ISU International Solo Ice Dance Competition Guidelines 2025/26

ISU General Rules and Requirements, and the International Solo Ice Dance Competition Guidelines 2025/26 Technical Rules and Level Requirements will be followed. Skaters must provide a passport or other proof of age to verify that skaters meet the age requirements as outlined in the International Solo Ice Dance Competition Guidelines 2025/26.

The Pattern Dances and Rhythm Dance will be skated prior to the Free Dance.

Age Requirements (**before 1 July preceding the competition**):

- Novice:
 - Basic Novice – has not reached the age of fourteen (**14**)
 - Intermediate Novice – has not reached the age of sixteen (**16**)
 - Advanced Novice – has reached the age of ten (10) and has not reached the age of eighteen (**18**)
- Junior: Has reached the age of thirteen (13) and has not reached the age of twenty one (**21**)
- Senior: Has reached at least the age of seventeen (**17**)



ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for all events will be £175. Entry fees are required to be paid at the time of entry. The Wonder Ice Academy will use an online registration and payment system for all registrations.

At the discretion of the Organising Committee late entries may be accepted and subject to a £50 late entry fee.

ELIGIBILITY

The UK Figure Skating members must meet BIS criteria to participate in these competitions. UK Skaters who have not paid their BIS membership at the time of the draw will not be entered into the draw and will be considered withdrawn. Refunds will not be issued for skater withdrawals for any reason

All entries must be submitted online by **Monday, 1st September 2025 at 5pm UK time**

COMPETITION REGISTRATION

Registration Deadline:

Monday 1st September 2025 @ 5 pm UK Time

Late Registration Deadline (if offered): Sunday, 14th September 2025 @ 5pm UK Time + £50 Late Fee

The organisers of the competition will:

Retain the right to refuse entry without reason assigned.

Retain the right of decision on all matters, their decision being final.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to close entries early if maximum capacity is reached. At the discretion of the Organizing Committee and the Referee, late entries may be accepted and are subject to a £50 late fee. **If late registration is opened, it will close by Sunday, 1st September 2025 @ 5pm UK Time or when maximum entries have been received / accepted.**

PANELS OF JUDGES

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one international judge or ISU judge educated in the ISU judging system. The organising committee reserves the right to limit the number of judges in accordance with number of entries. The organiser will cover accommodation for accepted judges and invited officials.

Meals for accepted judges and invited officials will be provided at the arena during the days of competition.

JUDGES, REFEREES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Organising committee will provide ground transportation and cover the expenses for accommodation and meals. Organiser will additionally cover economy roundtrip airfare for invited Technical Panel Officials (Referee, TC, TS, Data/Video) and invited judges.



TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATIONS

The closest airport, Manchester International Airport, is approximately 45min (38 miles) from the Blackburn Arena

ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation point will be at the **Blackburn Ice Rink** on Tuesday, 6th October upon arrival.

Accreditation will be given to all Competitors, Coaches, Judges and Officials.



OPENING DRAW

There will be an electronic draw - Friday, 3rd of October 2025

The Starting Order for Free Dances will be the reverse of the Pattern Dances and Rhythm Dances results.

RESULTS AND ISU MINIMUM SCORE

The ISU Judging System, as described in the International Solo Ice Dance Competition Guidelines, will be used.

This is not an ISU Minimum Technical Score event.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places of each event, and will be presented on the ice after the official results are certified. Skaters or designees who are not able to make the award ceremony may pick up their medal at the registration desk afterwards. Awards not collected by the close of the competition will be forfeited.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will not be issued for skater withdrawals for any reason unless the event is cancelled.

CHANGING AREAS

Dressing/changing rooms are available to skaters at this competition.

Dressing rooms are for athletes only and are labelled with regard to specific gender.

Athletes aged 11 years or younger may be accompanied by one parent of the same gender to assist their child immediately prior to and after their skating event(s).



MUSIC

Skaters are required to upload their music no later than **Monday, 1st September 2025 @ 5pm UK Time**

All music must meet the following criteria. If you have questions about what format you have, please contact your coach and get a new version of your music that meets the criteria listed below.

Music must be uploaded in MP3 format

Each Skater must have their own back-up drive (USB stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file.

The Blackburn Arena will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the Competition.

PRACTICE ICE

Unofficial practice ice will be available for purchase. A schedule of practice ice sessions will be posted on the website, Facebook and Spornity App soon after the competition schedule is published.

The unofficial practice ice fee is £10 for 20 minutes per skater.
