CATEGORIES & SPECIFICATION:

The "NRW Trophy for synchronized Skating" 2015 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2014, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2014 as well as all pertinent ISU communications.

The judging system is the new judging system. Free program factor: 1.7 Falls: - 0.5

Teams may enter more than one category using different music and a different program, with a minimum 50% change in skaters. Only those skaters whose names are listed on the registration form will be allowed to skate.

The free skating program must be a well-balanced program according to ISU Regulations for Synchronized Skating 2014.

Category JUVENILE - free program

The following 6 elements are mandatory:

1 × Block Intersection Element (pi not counted)
1 × Linear Element - Line
1 × Pivoting Element – Block
1 × Rotating Element - Circle
1 × Traveling Element – Wheel
1 × Choice of one (1) of the following Elements: - Creative Element OR - Combined Element

Juvenile: Free program **3:00 min** (plus or minus 10 s).
Less than 13 years before 1st of July 2014.
80% / 20% rule: At least 80% must meet the age category and max. 20% or less may be outside the age criteria.

Composition: **8-16 skaters** with a maximum of 4 alternates.
Teams may include both boys and girls without restrictions

The final results will be calculated according to **ISU rules for basic novice**.

Category MIXED-AGE Age - free program

The following 7 elements are mandatory:

1 × Intersection Element
1 × Linear Element – Line
1 × No Hold Element
1 × Pivoting Element – Block
1 × Rotating Element - Circle
1 × Traveling Element – Wheel
1 × Choice of one (1) of the following Elements: - Creative Element OR - Combined Element

Mixed age: Free program **3:30 min** (plus or minus 10 s) - **No age limit**

Composition: **8-16 skaters** with a maximum of 4 alternates.
Teams may include both boys/men and girls/women without restrictions

The final results will be calculated according to **ISU rules for advanced novice**.

The planned program must be sent to the organizing committee before January 10, 2015.

JUDGES, REFEREE AND TECHNICAL

Judges panel:

1 Referee, 1 Assistant Referee ice, 3 or 5 Judges

Technical panel:

1 Technical Controller, 1 Technical Specialist, 1 Data Operator, 1 Video Replay Operator

Each participant country may enter two judges on synchronized skating. Travel and accommodation will be paid for the technical panel by the organizing committee as well as the accommodation for the judges.

JUDGES MEETING

Referee, Judges and TC Meeting will take place at Eissporthalle Südpark on Saturday, February 14, 2015 at appr. 12:00 am (see time schedule).

ENTRIES

The entry fee is 240 Euros (€) for each participating team.

Preliminary entries (Form 1) per Team, indicating participation of the ISU Member or Club, have to be submitted **not later than Dec 12, 2014** (we would appreciate early entries - for planning purpose) - while Final Team Entries, with the name of selected team and judge (Form 2-7), must be submitted **not later than January 10, 2015**.

Should a team withdraw from the event after that date, no amount will be returned.

The organizer has the right to reject entries, if there are more than 15 team entries. The organizer will prefer early preliminary entries.

REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

The registration for Referees, Judges, Teams, Accredited Coaches and Team Managers/-Leaders will take place at 11 am at the ice rink Eissporthalle Suedpark (Jakob-Koch-Str. 1, 41466 Neuss) on Saturday, February 14, 2015.

MUSIC

All teams shall provide their competition music of excellent quality on Compact Disk or better as MP3 on USB-Stick or **as an MP3-File via E-Mail**. All CD's or USB-Sticks must be properly inserted in their original container and be clearly identified with the name of the team and must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time).

The organizer will prefer the music as MP3-file sent via mail not later than Feb 10, 2015 to info@nsk-neuss.de.

WARM UP

During the competition, there will be dedicated warm up areas in and around the ice rink.

PRACTICE ICE

Each team will be allocated a ten (10) minutes practice session for free program. The official practice will start on Saturday, February 14, 2015, at appr. 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm (see time schedule). Additional practice time can not be provided at February 14, 2015.

STARTING ORDER

The starting order will be determined by draw in alphabetical order of countries. The draw will be made by the team volunteers about 10 days before the competition.

OPENING CEREMONY

At the Opening Ceremony, each team is requested to participate with all skaters. The Opening Ceremony will be held after the official training at appr. 6:00 pm (see time schedule)

COMPETITION TIME

The competition will start with the opening ceremony at appr. 6:00 pm.

MEDALS AND TROPHIES

The three best-placed teams will be announced and honored at the official Award Ceremony. The national anthem of the winner will be played. All members of all the participating teams will receive a souvenir.

CLOSING CEREMONY – PODIUMS

All participants must be present on ice for the announcement of the result and for the prize awarding ceremony.

All participants must be part of the closing ceremony and follow the organization decided by the Organization Committee.

ORGANIZATION

The organization of the competition is the responsibility of the NSK. It reserves the right to take any measures necessary to ensure that the competition runs smoothly.

All decisions concerning such measures will be taken with the agreement of the Referee.

LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the organizer accepts no liability for injury or damage sustained by competitors or officials. The organizer will not provide participant insurance coverage for the event. Each member or club is expected to provide its own insurance protection.

The organizer will provide emergency medical services for all participants during the competition and official practice.

PUBLICITY WAIVER

Each individual and/or team waive any and all rights to financial remuneration or other compensation for the use or reproduction of their image or likeness, or that of their synchronized skating team, and grant permission to use same, as or publicity prior to, during or following the NRW-Trophy for Synchronized Skating 2015 in Neuss, Germany.

TEAM ACCOMMODATION

The NSK has a list available of possible hotel accommodations in Neuss. Reservations have to be made directly to the chosen hotel.

MEALS

During the competition, the bistro "Kufenstübchen" at the ice rink will provide meals and drinks at one's own expense. Fruits and water will be provided in the changing room.

PRELIMINARY SCHEDULE

The competition will be held after the Quirinus Cup 2015 (a local cup for single skaters). This competition will be held between 8:00 am and 1:00 pm and the schedule will be defined according to the number of teams registered and the number of skaters registered for the Quirinus Cup. The preliminary schedule is as follows: official training will be held from 1:00 pm until 6:00 pm; the opening ceremony will take place at around 6:00 pm and will be followed by the competition. The closing ceremony will start with the award ceremony for the NRW-Trophy for SYS and will be followed by awarding the national champions. The practice and competition schedule are subjects to change. The organizing committee would be grateful to you to let them be informed of your participation as soon as possible as well as your arrival time and date, so that they could arrange a balanced timetable. The final schedule will be communicated after the teams have registered for the competition. Changes during the competition will be communicated asap and will also be available at the ice rink.

Each team will be guided by a "NSK-Volunteer" during their visit in Neuss to organize all circumstances.

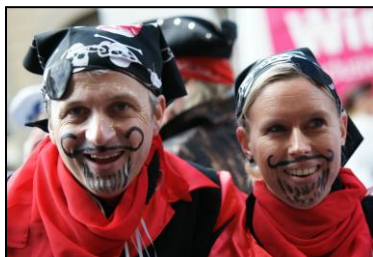

Information about the „Carnival“-season in the Rhineland



Background:

Everyone knows about the „Carnival in Rio“ – but also the carnival in the Rhineland area, in Mainz, Cologne or Düsseldorf is famous around the world. Cologne, Düsseldorf and Mainz are held in the public media to be Germany's three carnival "strongholds", but carnival celebrations are also widespread elsewhere in the Rhineland – for example in Neuss. The main carnival parades in Cologne or Düsseldorf take place on Monday - called "Rosenmontagszug" (Rose Monday parade) – therefore in Neuss the people celebrate one day earlier: on Sunday – called "Kappessonntagszug" ("sauerkraut parade").

Beginning early in the history of humans, already the old Greek and Romans catered feasts in spring in the honor of "Dionysos" and "Saturn" – with lots of wine, women and singing. Germanic peoples celebrated winter solstice in honor of the Gods and to drive off bad winter demons. Later, the Christians took over these profane rites and the "Fastnacht" or the "Karneval" (latin: carne vale = "farewell to meat") occurred before lent. Today carnival is being celebrated with parades, balls etc.. People put on costumes and shout the battle cry "Helau" – as a reward they receive "Strüssje" (flower bouquets) and "Kamelle" (candies).

The NRW-Trophy for synchronized Skating 2015 will be held on Saturday, February 14, 2015. The next day, the club members of the Neuss skating club (NSK) will meet at 11:00 a.m. in the Neuss city to take part at the "Kappessonntagszug".

The NSK invites now all participants of the NRW-Trophy for synchronized Skating to take part at the "Kappessonntagszug" – it's gonna be a fun time.

The traditional parade "Kappessonntagszug" in the city of Neuss with funny costumes will take place from 1:00 pm - appr. 3:00 pm. About ½ mill. people stand along the streets and are waiting for "Kamelle" (candies) and "Strüssjes" (small bunches of flowers).

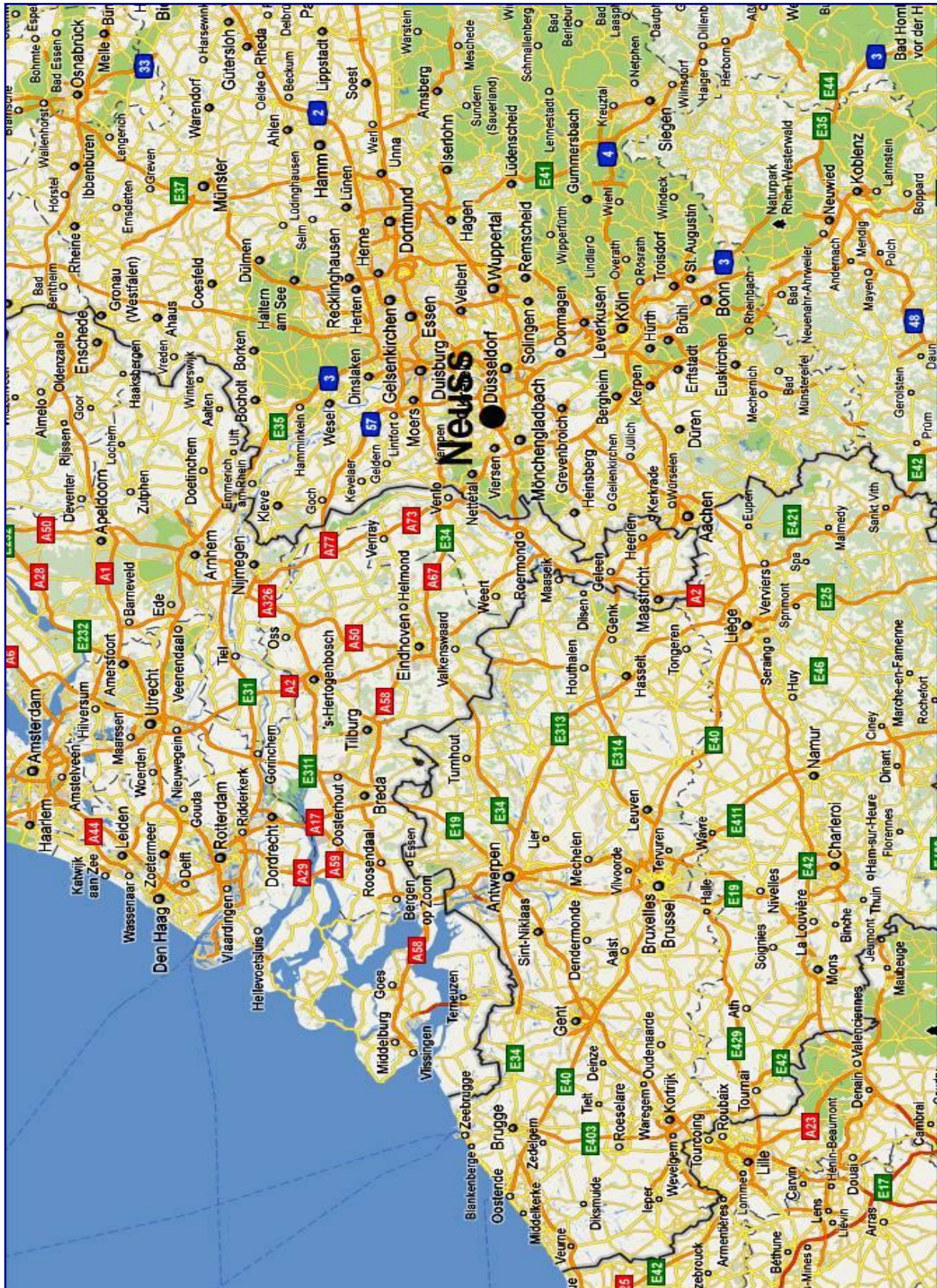

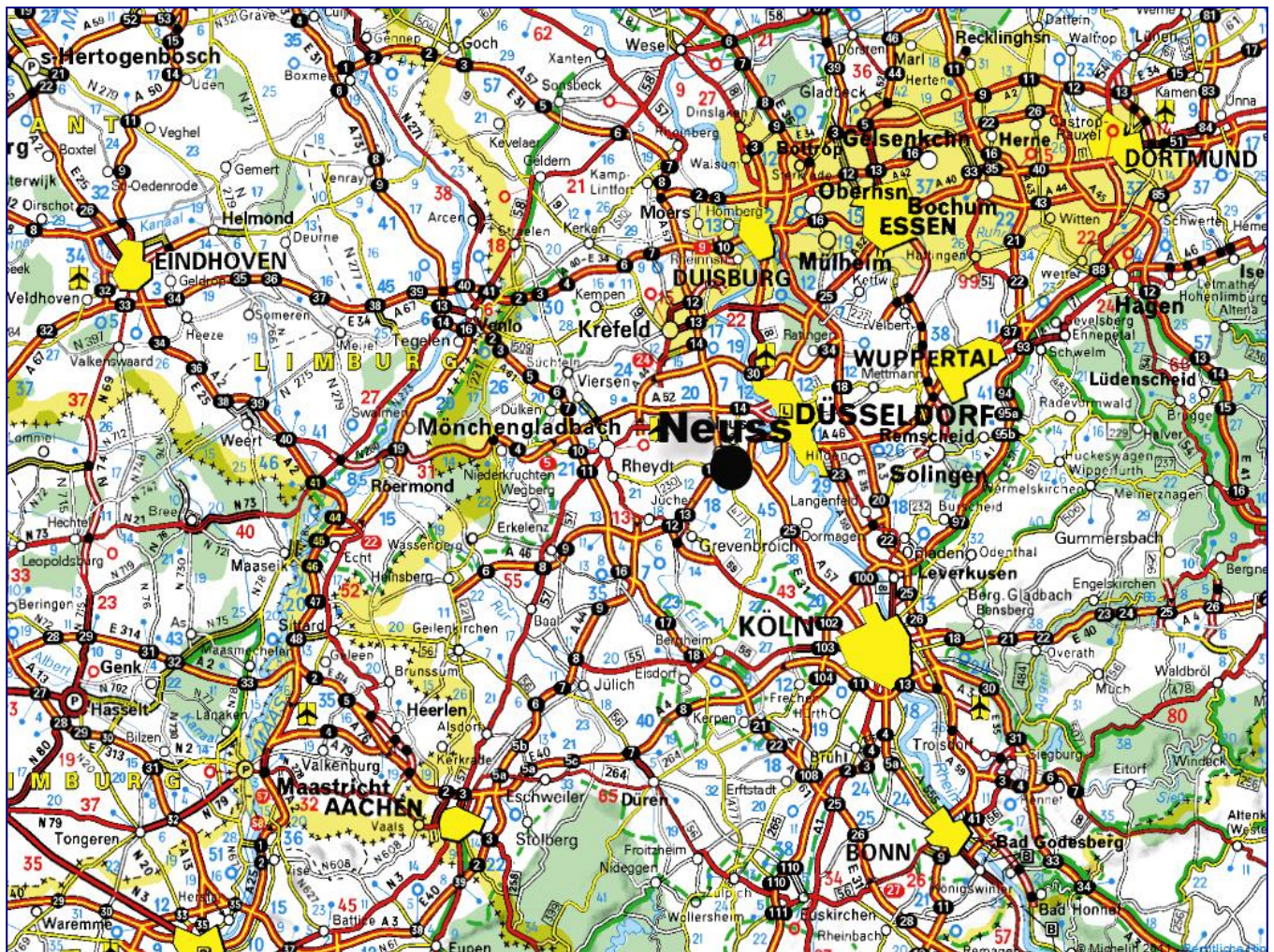

Neuss am Rhein

SOMETHING ABOUT NEUSS:

Neuss was founded by the Romans 2.000 years ago where the river „Erft“ meets the „Rhine“. Neuss is one of the oldest settlements in Germany. The city is home to the head offices of many national and international companies and corporations.

The Neuss-Duesseldorf-Harbour is Germany's third-largest river port.



Neuss is situated just west of the Rhine river, where the state capital of Northrhine-Westfalia (NRW) Düsseldorf is located. Neuss is a Roman city, a Hanseatic city and a place of pilgrimage. With around 154,000 citizens living on 100 square kilometers Neuss is today Germany's largest district city.

In the „Rhein-Kreis-Neuss“-District around 500.000 inhabitants form a strong community.

One attraction, that reaches far beyond the city's and the Rhein-Kreis Neuss border is the „Neuss Bürger-Schützenfest“ (marksmen festival): More than half a million visitors come to Neuss each year in autumn at the end of August to celebrate the festival in the old city and to cheer for the marksmen marching for the king.

The Neuss-Partner-Cities are: Châlons-en-Champagne (France), Rijeka (Croatia), Pskow (Russia), Saint Paul (USA) and Nevsehir (Turkey).



North Rhine-Westfalia - NRW

North Rhine-Westfalia - NRW - is the state "deep in the West" of Germany. NRW is Germany's largest state by population, it is home to some 18 million people. With an area of about 34,000 square kilometres, NRW is the fourth largest federal state of Germany by area, making it a little larger than the US state of Maryland or half the size of Scotland. North Rhine-Westfalia is the most populous of the 16 German states, which also means that more people live in this state than, for instance, in the Netherlands, in Belgium, in Austria or in Switzerland.

After world war II, the British Military Government's created the State of North Rhine-Westfalia on August 23, 1946, by merging the northern part of the former Prussian Rhine Province with Westfalia, another province of the now defunct state of Prussia.

Nowhere else in Germany are industrial and rural regions so close to each other. There is hardly any other region on earth with a similar concentration of museums, theatres, opera houses, sport facilities concert and event halls. In NRW are 29 cities with more than 100,000 residents. The largest city in North Rhine-Westfalia is Cologne with a population of about one million, Duesseldorf is the state capital of North Rhine-Westfalia with about 500.000.
