6. Expenses

Travel expenses, accommodation and meals are at the charge of all participants. Organizer will not cover any expenses of competitors.

7. Liability

The organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the competition.

In accordance with ISU Regulations, Rule 119, the organizers may not be help responsible for eventual accidents or other damages to participants, officials or third parties. All participants act at their own responsibility.

8. Music

Music will be produced from a CD-player. CD's must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate CD. In addition, competitors must have a backup CD ready for each program.

9. Calculation of results

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single Skating, Rule 352, will be in place in all categories.

10. Awards

The three best competitors of each event will be awarded with trophies. All other competitors will receive a gift.

11. Draws
