



9th BIASCA-TROPHY Synchronized Skating 2/3 April 2016

The Skating Club of Biasca invite your teams to participate at the Biasca Trophy 2016, Synchronized Skating Competition, all categories, with the agreement of Swiss Ice Skating.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the ISU and is opened to all eligible Team Skaters according to ISU Rule 102.

Technical regulations and conditions: The Biasca-Trophy 2016 will be held according to the ISU General Regulations 2014, the Special Regulations Synchronized Skating 2014 as well as the valid Technical Rules and Conditions SYS 2015 of the Swiss Skating Union (SEV).

Important: The organiser advises the teams of the Non-ISU categories to refer to the special and adjusted Technical Conditions SYS (see Technical Guidelines for Competitions in Switzerland 2015/2016).

Teams, which have participated in the ongoing season in a certain category, are not allowed to take part in another category at the Biasca Trophy.

Judging system

The competition will be judged with the ISU Judging System.

Categories:

Seniors	short program and free skating
Juniors	short program and free skating
Advanced Novice	free skating
Basic Novice	free skating
Mixed Age *	free skating
Senior Non-ISU	free skating
Adults	free skating

** In case of a large number of entries to the Mixed Age category, the organizer reserves the right to split up this category into two (2) age-related groups.*

Music:

Two (2) copies (original and back-up copy) for each program (short/free) must be submitted by each Team. All music must be clearly identified with the name of the Team, the type of Program (short /free program) and must show the exact running time of the music (not the skating time) Each program (short /free) must be recorded on one track and on a separate disk.

Registration:

Participating teams and Officials are invited to register upon arrival. A welcome desk will be in place at the Ice Rink, during all the time of the competition:

Saturday April 2, 2015, from 8h00 to 17h00

Sunday April 3, 2015, from 8h00 to 12h00

Entries / Information:

Competitors entries are accepted from invited ISU Members or their affiliated clubs/associations (with approval of the ISU Member concerned)

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Deadline:

Entries should be received with the official entry form **not later than January 15, 2016**

Entrance fee:

CHF 370.00 per team in all categories.

Entrance fees are non-refundable.

Judges:

Each participating ISU-Member entering at least 2 teams may enter one (1) International Judge or ISU-Judge for Synchronized Skating from the official ISU list of judges for the current season. National Championship Judges may also be entered.

The organiser will pay board and lodging from Saturday, April 2 to Sunday evening, April 3, 2016. All other expenses shall be the responsibility of each official or the entering association or club.

Judges Meeting:

The first judges meeting will take place Saturday, April 2, 2016 at around 12h00 at the Ice Rink.

The Round table discussion will be held on Sunday, April 3, 2016 after the competition at the Ice Rink.

Official Practice:

The official practice begins on Saturday, April 2, 2016. Each team has 10 minutes official practice on ice for the short program and 12 minutes, or 10 minutes for Novice Basic and Adult, for the free skating program.

On April 2 / 3 the ice is reserved for the official practice only.

The official practices are compulsory.

Additional Practice Ice is available on Friday, April 1, 2016, from 15h00 – 22h00 for Swiss Francs 50.— per 15 minutes.
