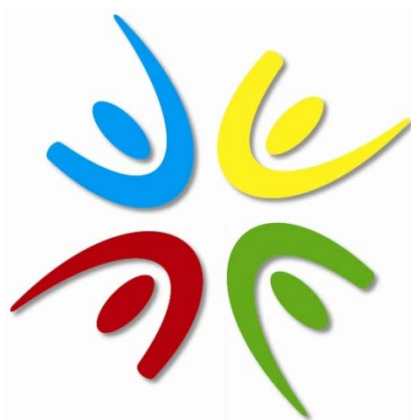

Introduction

On behalf of the Icelandic Skating Association we would like to invite you to participate in the Interclub Figure Skating Competition at the Reykjavik International Games 2016 (RIG).

It is a pleasure to welcome figure skaters from figure skating clubs and national figure skating federations associated with the ISU to participate in this interclub figure skating competition for young and upcoming skaters. The competition is at the same time as our ISU competition for Senior/Junior/Advanced Novice.

This will be the 8th year figure skating is part of the Reykjavik International Games, the second year on the list of ISU for the older categories. As before the Figure Skating Club of Reykjavik will be hosting the competition. Reykjavik International Games is a multi athletic event that the city of Reykjavik hosts. 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

Reykjavik International Games will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2014, the ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating 2014 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participating skaters in RIG must belong to an ISU Member, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, provided their age is within the limits specified in this document in paragraph 3. Rules.

Entry can be done by ISU member or by club.

The competition will be held in Skautahöllin in Laugardalur, Reykjavik.

3. RULES

The competition will be conducted in accordance with ÍSS (Icelandic skating association) competition rules. See the end of this document for details.

12 years and younger A, girls	Age: not older than 12 on July 1, 2015	FS	ÍSS rule
13 years and younger A, boys	Age: not older than 13 on July 1, 2015	FS	ÍSS rule
10 years and younger A, girls	Age: not older than 10 on July 1, 2015	FS	ÍSS rule
11 years and younger A, boys	Age: not older than 11 on July 1, 2015	FS	ÍSS rule
8 years and younger A, girls	Age: not older than 8 on July 1, 2015	FS	ÍSS rule
9 years and younger A, boys	Age: not older than 9 on July 1, 2015	FS	ÍSS rule

Confirmation of the skaters accepted to the competition will be published on the website not later than **December 12, 2015**.



6. PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All competitors are asked to email their planned program content sheet (RIG04) to email-address: events@skautasamband.is on or before December 20, 2015. The sheet must be completed in English using the terminology listed in ISU Communication 1884. Please use the planned element document on the website of the competition form RIG04.

7. ENTRY FEE

We kindly ask members/clubs to make **one payment transaction for all their skaters.**

In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category by another skater from the same member until **January 15, 2016**. Participating members are asked to immediately inform of any changes in their entries by email to events@skautasamband.is.

Entry fees are not refunded in case of withdrawal after **December 20, 2015**.

8. MUSIC

Music must be provided on CD (no CD-RW-s or DVD-s). The CDs equipped with the full name of the competitor, club and category must be submitted to the Organizer at the accreditation. **All competitors must have an extra copy of their music available at the rink during their event.**

9. ACCREDITATION

The Accreditation will be open at the official hotel Thursday January 21 from 18.00-23.00. The accreditation will be moved the rink on Friday January 22 at 08.00.

10. PROTESTS

Protests must be submitted according to rule 123.

11. AWARDS

The three best placed skaters in each category will be announced and honoured. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medallists.

12. EXPENSES

The Organizer will not cover any expenses of the teams. Travel expenses, board and accommodation will be covered by the participants.



13. TRANSPORTATION

Travel to Reykjavík:

Keflavík airport is the only international airport and it takes approx. 50 minutes to get from the airport to Reykjavík with fly-bus. Buses are available from Keflavík airport and should stop at the official hotel.

All Competitors, Team Leaders and Coaches taking part in the competition are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but no later than December 20, 2015, the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival at Keflavík International Airport or any other information concerning transportation and arrivals. The travel form RIG03 should be used.

14. ACCOMODATION

The competitors and their coaches are responsible for booking their accommodations at the official hotel.

15. PROTOCOL/LIST OF RESULTS

Protocol/ list of results in each category will be published on the website of the competition.

16. LIABILITY

According to the ISU Regulations, Rule 119 the Organizer accepts no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury, property loss or damage suffered by the competitors or officials during the competition.

Participants are expected to provide their own insurances. Such insurance must assure full medical attention and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior – see ISU Rules

*Note on technical score for step sequence: To receive level Basic it needs to include at least 3 turns and 2 steps, use the whole ice surface and have constant flow. If not then no value will be given.

**Note on technical score for choreseq: This is not a ChSq according to the ISU rules. Must include 2 spirals for 3 sec. on an edge (change of foot is required) in order to be confirmed by the technical panel and receive a fixed base value mark. The free foot needs to be higher than hip level. Pattern is optional, jumps and spins may not be included in the pattern. If a jump/spin is executed between the 3 sec. spirals the sequence stops and will receive no value.
