for Advanced, Intermediate and Basic Novice, and younger categories

1. **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

The **Black Sea Ice Cup 2025** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Black Sea Ice Cup 2025** is open to all Competitors who belongs to an ISU Member and qualify regarding eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3.

2. **TECHNICAL DATA:**

2.1 **PLACE OF THE COMPETITION:**

Black Sea Ice Arena, Zlatna ribka 8, 9649 Kranevo, Bulgaria – an indoor ice-rink with ice surface of 26 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated.



2.2 **CATEGORIES:**

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2624 and all respective ISU Communications.

Short Program: 2 min 20 sec, +/-10 sec

Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2624 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2624 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CUBS GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements – Cubs is a skater who was born: 1.7.2014 – 30.6.2016.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump.

One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value.

No triple or quadruple jumps are allowed.

Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination, and one must be a spin with no change of position and no change of foot.

The spin combination with a change of foot must have a minimum of eight (8) revolutions and without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. Flying entry is allowed. If with a change of foot, only one level feature per foot will count.

The spin in one position without change of foot must have a minimum of six (6) revolutions, must be done in a basic position without any difficult variation positions and will be called maximum level basic. After the required revolutions it is allowed to execute difficult variations, but these will be ignored by the Technical Panel. Flying entry is not allowed.

c) There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface and including at least one skating movement such as a spiral, spread eagle, Ina Bauer, hydroblading etc. If the skating movement is missing, no Level will be given. The Technical Panel will not award Feature 3)

Use of body movements for at least 1/3 of the pattern and Feature 4) Two combinations of 3 difficult turns on different feet.

Levels explanations:

For Cubs, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The following Program Components are judged:

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The factor for the Program Components is 1.67

CHICKS GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements - Chicks Skater is a skater who was born: 1.7.2016 and younger.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

a) Maximum of four (4) jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump.

One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value.

No triple or quadruple jumps are allowed.

Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once.

The following Program Components are judged:

- Composition

The factor for the Program Components is 1.67

The same ISU refereeing rules and work of the Technical Panel will be applied as in a Juniors and Seniors international competitions.

3. ENTRIES:

All ISU members and clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part at the competition.

Entries will be accepted from Member Federations or clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU.

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

Entry forms must reach the Event Organizer not later than March 15, 2025.

Entry forms can be downloaded from the ISU website or from the official website of SC Ice Sports Varna – <https://icesportsvarna.com>.

The organizer will not cover any expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches, or chaperons.

4. CANCELLATION:

Cancellation of the competitor entry must be done till **March 25, 2025**. For any latter cancellation the team leader of respective Federation or Club will be asked to pay the entry fee.

5. JUDGES:

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge. Nomination for Judge and substitute Judge must be sent along with the entry forms for competitors. The official entry form for Judges must reach the Organizing Committee, not later than **March 15, 2025**.

The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw.

Each panel of Judges in Juniors and Seniors categories will consist of minimum 5 Judges.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators and confirmed Judges at Therma Eco Village****, beginning with dinner on Wednesday, April 2, 2025, until lunch on Monday, April 7, 2025.

Travel expenses will be covered only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

6. ENTRY FEE:

Advanced Novice – **€ 85 per skater, paid until 15 of March. Late payment – € 110 per skater.**

Younger categories – **€ 75 per skater, paid until 15 of March. Late payment – € 100 per skater.**

Payment shall be made by bank transfer before the deadline or on spot, only cash after the deadline in the office of the Organizing Committee in the Black Sea Ice Arena during the accreditation.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

7. MUSIC:

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations Technical Rules Single Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- The participating member is responsible for submitting the Competitor's music as attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (music@bsf.bg) until **March 15, 2025**. Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service

which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

- Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment, and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

- The music files must be sent as **MP3 file format**. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file.

- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.

8. CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS:

Results for all categories will be calculated using the new ISU Judging System. The results and any additional information for the event you can find on icesportsvarna.com.

9. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES:

The three best placed Skaters in each event will be announced and honoured. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be presented to the medallists. All skaters will receive a diploma.

10. LIABILITY:

According to ISU regulations, the Event Organizer accepts no liability for bodily harm, personal injury and loss of property or damages incurred by any competitor(s) or official(s).

11. ACCREDITATION:

The accreditation will start on Wednesday, April 2, 2025, at 15:00 h. in the office of the Organizing Committee at the Black Sea Ice Arena.

12. DRAW:

The draw for the order of skating will be held electronically on Monday, March 31, 2025, and will be published on the competition website.

Starting order for the free skating of category Advanced Novice will be in reverse order of the results in short program.

13. ADDITIONAL PRACTICE:

Rates for additional practice hours are as follow:

1-hour private practice – € 200.

1-hour open practice together with another teams – € 25 per skater.
