- Capacity of the arena: 5,500 people
- Warm up area

- Railway station 500 m away from the ice rink

TECHNICAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

10th PGE Hevelius Cup 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating, and the relevant ISU Communications. The teams must belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 7) and the age must be within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 4. All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102 and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109.

Pre-Juvenile: The free program of the category Pre-Juvenile will be according to the rules of the Basic Novice. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who have not reached the age of 11 by 1 July 2025 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category, the rest of the team can be older by a maximum of 1 age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

Juvenile: The free program of the category Juvenile will be according to the rules of the Basic Novice. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who have not reached the age of 13 by 1 July 2025 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category, the rest of the team can be older by a maximum of 1 age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

Basic Novice: The free program of the category Basic Novice will be according to the rules of the Basic Novice. Shall consist of 12-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 10 but have not reached the age of 16 by 1 July 2025 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category, the rest of the team can be younger or older by a maximum of 1 age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

Junior B: The free program of the category Junior B will be according to the rules of the Junior. Shall consist of 12-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 13 but have not reached the age of 19 by 1 July 2025 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category, the rest of the team can be younger or older by a maximum of 1 age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

- Elements: Comm. 2692 Junior Free Skating Program (only free program).

Mixed Age: The free program of the category Mixed Age will be according to the rules of the Mixed Age. Shall consist of 12-16 skaters + max 4 alternates. No age limit.

- Free Program: 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 sec), Factor 2.67.
- Elements: Comm. 2692 Mixed Age Free Skating Program.
- Follows the General rules for Junior category. Illegal Elements are following the restriction of Rule 992 para 2. c)

Adult: The free program of the category Adult will be according to the rules of Technical Requirements for Synchronized Skating for ISU Adult Figure Skating Technical Requirements 2025-2026. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 18 by 1 July 2025 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

- Elements: Technical Requirements for Synchronized Skating for ISU Adult Figure Skating Technical Requirements 2025-2026.

ENTRIES/REGISTRATION:

Preliminary Entries have to be sent to the Organizing Committee of 10th PGE Hevelius Cup 2026: heveliuscup@iceskater.pl **not later than 1 November 2025.**

Final Entries have to be sent **not later than 14 December 2025.**

All team members will need to identify themselves with a passport or an identity card when registering at the event.

ENTRY FEE:

All categories: **600 euro per Team**

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawal for any reason.

UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE:

Unofficial practice ice is available for all teams on the 16,17 January 2026, at Hala Olivia on official or practice ice rink (both rinks are in this same building and have 30 x 60 meter).

TIME SCHEDULE:

The competition will be held on 18 January 2026.
The schedule will be published after the entry on 22 December 2025.

JUDGES, REFEREE AND TECHNICAL PANEL:

The Competition will be judged under the ISU system. Panel of Judges for each competition will consist of:

- 1 Referee,
- 1 Referee's Assistant Ice Level,
- 5 Judges,
- 1 Technical Controller,
- 2 Technical Specialists,
- 2 Data/Replay operator.

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge, listed on the ISU List of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating. The Entries of Judges must be made not later than: **14 December 2025**.

The Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators will be nominated by the Organizing Committee. Travel, accommodation and meals will be paid for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators by the Organizing Committee.

DRAW:

The draw will take place **electronically** on 12 January 2026. The starting order will be published on the website www.heveliuscup.eu

CLOSING CEREMONY :

The closing ceremony will be held right after the end of the competition day 18 January 2026. Trophies will be awarded to the top three teams of each category.
