1. WELCOME

The Organizing Committee is glad to invite you and your club to participate to the 3RD MONT BLANC TROPHY ISU International Competition.

The Organizers reserve the right to change the date and program of the competition.

When submitting an entry all competitors acknowledge that due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and public health issues the Organizers can only host the competition in accordance with the effective national medical and government regulations and has the solemn right to cancel the competition at any time or to host it between closed doors with a limited number of competitors and no spectators.

Furthermore, in case the competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues the Organizers bear no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the Organizers.

The Organizers are not obliged to assign a new date for the competition if it is cancelled because of the above-mentioned reasons.

The competitors acknowledge that upon cancellation of the competition they do not have the right to claim back the already paid entry fee.

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **MONT BLANC TROPHY 2022 International Competition in Figure Skating and Pairs Skating** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and the relevant ISU Communications.

Novice categories will be held in accordance with ISU Communication 2489 and subsequent updates.

The Participation in the Mont Blanc Trophy is open for skaters who belong to an invited ISU Member, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must present an ISU Clearance Certificate.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented for verification at the accreditation of the event.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR WOMEN AND MEN

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022 Rule 611, Paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2022/2023
Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS AND BOYS

Short Program: In accordance with ISU Communication No. 2489 or any subsequent updates
Duration: 2 min., 20 sec. +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Communication No. 2489 or any subsequent updates
Duration: 3 min., +/- 10 sec

SENIOR PAIR SKATING

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 2 for 2022/23.
Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2022, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR PAIR SKATING

- Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022*, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2022/23.
Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.
- Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2022, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.
Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec

4. ENTRIES

4.1 ENTRIES OF COMPETITORS

Each Federation can enter maximum 2 competitors per category plus 1 substitute, no limits for Italian Federation.

Depending on the number of participants the organization will decide whether or not to accept extra entries. Please note that the organizer may divide categories with too many entries into subgroups.

Each category can have a maximum of 24 competitors.

Entries by names must be sent not later than Friday, October 28, 2022 – 18:00 h (local time Courmayeur)

4.2 ENTRIES OF JUDGES

Each participating Federation may nominate judges with the qualification "Judge for International competitions" or "ISU Judge". The nominated judge must be on the current ISU list of Officials (ISU Communication No. 2420).

The organizer decides on the composition of the panel of judges.

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges after the closing date for the entries.

The written confirmation will be sent to each federation immediately.

The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the respective Member Federation/Association not later than Friday, October 28, 2022 – 18:00 h (local time Courmayeur)

4.3 ENTRIES OF TEAM OFFICIALS

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff, Coaches and Chaperones must be made via the ORS. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one (1) Coach and one (1) Chaperone per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

5. ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee must be paid not later than **October 28th 2022**.

All later payments will be considered as late entry fee.

CANCELLATION

The eventual withdrawal of one competitor or pair, has to be done until November 1st, 2022.

For any later cancellation the Federations will be asked to pay the entry fee.

After November 1st , 2022 The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

6. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators and Judges participating, beginning with dinner on Wednesday November 23rd until lunch on Sunday, November 27th2022

Should any of the above-mentioned persons arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators.

The accreditation will be at the Ice Rink from Friday 25th of November.

Accreditation will be given to all drawn judges, competitors and one coach per competitor.

All competitors are requested to present a valid passport or personal identity card at the time of registration.

10. PRACTICE

Official practice for only Senior competitors (Pairs, Women and Men) begins on November 24th.

The detailed schedule will be sent after the closing of entries.

It is possible to buy extra ice sessions for exclusive practice on ice at 100,00 € per hour or share the practice sessions with other athletes at 15,00 € per person per hour (max 20 athletes on the ice).

11. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance.

Musics must be sent in .mp3 file to montblanc trophy@gmail.com.

Each program (short program, free skating) must be saved in a separate file and should be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment, the names of the competitor and the exact running time of the music.

12. DRAW

The starting order will be drawn in the headquarter of the Italian Ice Sports Federation FISG on Thursday, November 3rd. No draw after short program. Starting order for free skating will be according the reverse of the short program results.

13. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

14. AWARDING CEREMONY

The three best placed Skaters/Couples in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists.

15. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Mont Blanc Trophy 2022, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

Furthermore, the OC is not responsible for any contagion that occurs at the event outside of compliance with the prevention protocols implemented.
