PLACE

The competition will be held at Palaghiaccio- via Fersina 15 – Località Ghiaie – Trento.

It is an indoor, heated, (30mx60m) rink

RULES

Trento Cup 2019 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2018, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

The Synchronized Skating teams will be allowed to participate with up to 2 skaters, alternates included, with no age restriction for each category.

The final results for the Junior and Senior categories will be determined as a combined result according to the ISU Regulations 2018 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

The advanced novice category will compete with two free programs, the same free skating will be skated twice. The result of the advanced novice category will be determined as a combine result according to the ISU Communication n.2238 Guidelines for International Novice Competitions and Well-balanced Program Requirements, the total segment score for each free skating will be multiplied by 0.5 factor and added together to the Teams Total Competition Score.



CATEGORIES

Synchronized Skating: Senior, Junior Short and Free Program
 Advanced Novice Free Program (skated twice, 1st free skating, 2nd free skating)

ENTRIES

Each club may entry up to one (1) team for Synchronized Skating for each category.

After the deadline of entries, the organizing committee may decide if more than the allowed teams could be accepted.

Here enclosed can be found the Entry Form 2 for Synchronized Skating teams.

The entries of the Italian Teams must be done through fisgonline.

REGISTRATION

The registration will take place at Palaghiaccio in Trento starting on Friday, Nov. 8th, 2019 at 13:00 p.m.

JUDGES

Each participating ISU Member is entitled to nominate one (1) ISU or International or National Judge possibly eligible for both Singles Skating and Synchronized Skating, **within Oct. 8th** sending the Form 3 to the Organizing Committee. There will be no restriction in the number of the nominated Judges for the hosting ISU Member).

Each panel of Judges will consist of 3 Judges.

The Organizing Committee will draw the Panel of Judges after the closing of entries.

The concerned ISU Members will then be notified of the result of draw.

MONITORING SESSION

At the end of the competition the participating teams will have the possibility to take part to a monitoring session on their programs. Coaches and skaters can get feedbacks on the programs from a group of officials and ask questions to improve their performance. 15/20 minutes will be reserved for each participating team with video analysis.

The monitoring group will be composed but not only by Roberta Giuliani ISU Technical Specialist and appointed skater in the ISU SYS Technical Committee and Elisabetta Boschetto ISU Referee and ISU SYS Program Component Moderator.

More information will be given at the accreditation, if the teams are interested to be part of the monitoring process please inform the organizing committee.



MUSIC

Italian teams are requested to upload the music at fisgonline.

Foreign teams are requested to send a mp3 file copy to cpatrento@virgilio.it. All files must show the competitor's name, the nation and the exact running time of the music. Each program (short program, free skating) must be saved in a separate file.

All teams are recommended to have a CD copy at the competition.

PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET

Italian teams are requested to upload the p.p.c. at fisgonline.

Foreign teams are requested to return the p.p.c. with the entry forms to the Organizing Committee in time and it must be filled in precisely by each team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

DRAWS

The Opening Draw will be held at Palaghiaccio on Friday, November 8th, 2019, at 15:00.

The starting order of the 2nd Free Skating for Advanced Novice will follow the reverse order of the result after the 1st Free Skating.

The starting order of the Free Skating for Junior and Senior will follow the reverse order of the Short Program.

MEDALS AND TROPHIES

The top three participants of each category will receive a Trophy.

Souvenirs will be presented to all the athletes.

PARTICIPANTS ACCOMODATION

The Organizing Committee will not be in charge with accommodation and transportation for single skaters.

The Organizing Committee will provide the skaters with pertinent information of accommodation during the stay.

The hotel for the Officials will be booked directly by the Organizing Committee by receiving the pertinent entry form.

The Organizing Committee will cover the expenses of accommodation (full board) and transfer to/from the station/airport and the transportation from to hotel/ice rink for all the Officials. The travel expenses of the nominated Judges will be covered by the respective ISU Members.

The Organizing Committee will cover the travel expenses of the invited Officials (Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators), based on the economic air/train rates, after receiving the pertinent receipt. The invited Officials travelling with their own cars, will be reimbursed within the correspondent value of the train ticket, second class.

LIABILITY

The Organizing Committee, FISG, GUG, accept no liability for injury or damaged sustained by Competitors or Officials before, during and after the competition according to the ISU Regulation no.119.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control may be carried out during the competition according to the valid ISU Anti-Doping Code (ISU pertinent Communications).
