1. GENERAL

Skate Malmö 2020 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating 2018 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Skaters from all figure skating clubs and national figure skating federations associated with the ISU are invited to participate. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants in case the number of competitors is too high. The organizing club reserves the right to enter more competitors. The clubs are asked to list the skaters in the order in which they wish to be accepted to the competition. For Swedish skaters we will prioritise skaters with highest scores season 2019/2020.

3. ENTRIES

Entries of competitors

Entries must be made by name to anneli@malmokk.se not later than **January 18, 2020**. Enclosed entry form must be used. Planned Program Content (PPC) for each skater must be enclosed. Swedish skaters also have to do the entries and PPC in IndTA.

Confirmation will be announced until January 25 2020. Definite timetable and list of participants will be announced to all entered clubs in February 2020.

Entries of judges and technical panel

Each participating ISU Members and clubs with entries in at least two categories may suggest one international/national Judge, Technical Specialist or Technical controller. The organizer reserves the right to select the judges and Technical panel. Accommodation Thursday-Sunday and meals Friday breakfast until Sunday lunch will be paid for the selected judges by the organizer.

Deadline for Entries of Judges is **January 18, 2020**.

The confirmation of the list of judges will be announced until January 25, 2020.

6. ENTRY FEE

Entry fee: 100 EUR (925 SEK) for 2 programs, 80EUR (750SEK) for 1 program.
Practise fee: 6 EUR (55 SEK).

Payment must be made in advance not later than **30 January, 2020**. If a skater withdraws from the competition after 30 January 2020, the entry fee will not be refunded.

5. MUSIC

Music will be played from digital mp3 files. The organizer will provide a unique link by email to each club for music upload. Each skater is also responsible for bringing a CD as backup to the competition. The file name must clearly state full name of the competitor, program, country, name of club and the category in which the skater is entered. The last date for mp3 music file upload is January 30th 2020. Swedish skaters put their music file in indTA.

6. DRAW

Opening draw for all classes will be Thursday 5th March at Good Morning hotel Malmö. In the free skating the skaters will skate in reversed result order of the short program. Award ceremony will be off ice 10 minutes after the conclusion of each category.

6. TRANSPORTATION

Malmö KK will provide transport service upon request:

- From railway station Hyllie (for participants coming from Copenhagen airport – Kastrup) for 6 EUR (55 SEK)/person/one way.
- From Malmo airport- Sturup for 11 EUR (100 SEK)/person/one way and from the railway stations of Malmo for 6 EUR (55 SEK)/person/one way.
- Please, be informed that this service is only possible in case your travel details arrives to the organizer not later than **February 22, 2**
