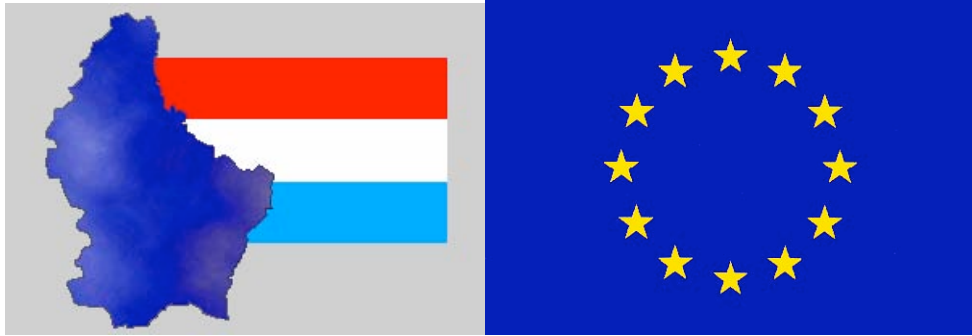

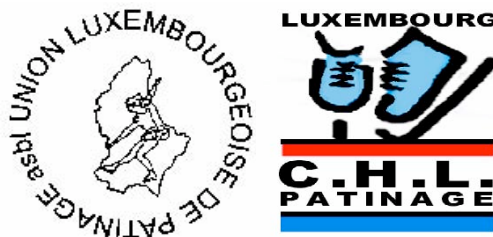

Entries

All nations, which are a member of the ISU, in accordance with Rule 107 paragraph 7, are invited to take part in the competition. ISU Members must enter competitors using the official entry form. The entries by name should arrive not later than **March 29th, 2009**

Due to the time available, the number of participants is limited to 100, which means that only the first 100 applicants will be retained.

Accommodations have to be reserved directly.

The organizers will cover hotel accommodation, meals and travel expenses for judges/referees/technical staff.

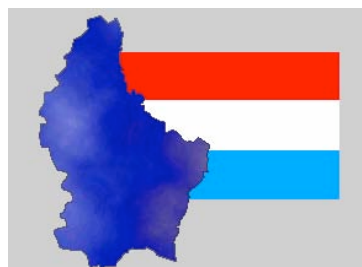

General regulations

The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2008, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pairs Skating 2008, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications for Juniors and Seniors. For Novice category the ISU Communication No 1397 will be applied.

Judging and calculation will be done according to the ISU special Regulations Single and Pair Skating 2008, rule 352 and 353.

Place

All competition events will take place in the “Public skating hall”, main arena. The official practices will take place in the practice arena. Both facilities are located next to each other in the same complex. Both are indoor, heated artificial ice surfaces.

Practice

For categories Novice girls/boys official practice will start on Friday, April 10th 2009 after the draw. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration.

Liability

In accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2008, rule 119, paragraph 2, the Organizing Committee assumes no liability for bodily or personal injury or for property loss or damage incurred in connection with the Event, by any Competitors or any kind of Officials.

Categories

Senior Ladies & Men

Short Program	In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 510, paragraph 1 and 2.
Duration:	2 min., 50 sec. maximum, but may be less, in accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 501.
Free Skating	In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 520. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration:	Men: 4 min. and 30 sec., +/- 10 seconds Ladies: 4 min., +/- 10 seconds In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 501

Junior Ladies & Men

Short Program	In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 510, paragraph 1 and 3, group A for 2008/2009
Duration:	2 min. 50 sec. maximum, but may be less, in accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 501.
Free Skating	In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 520. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration:	Men: 4 min., +/- 10 seconds Ladies: 3 min. 30 sec., +/- 10 seconds In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008; rule 501

Novice Girls & Boys

Age requirements: In international Novice competitions, a novice skater is a skater who may not be younger than 10 (ten) and must not have reached the age of 15 (fifteen) by July 1st preceding these events.

Short program	In accordance with ISU Communication 1397
Duration:	2 min. 30 sec., maximum
Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Communication 1397 Special attention should be paid to a well-balanced program.
Duration:	Boys: 3 min. 30 sec., +/- 10 seconds Girls: 3 min., +/- 10 seconds
