Entries of Officials: Each participating ISU Member or Club is requested to nominate a national or international TS, TC or Judge. The final composition of the panels will be done by lot and will be published to the participating ISU Member or Club in time.

Costs of Officials: The organizer will cover accommodation for **invited** officials. Meals for all officials will be provided at the ice-rink during the days of competition.

Time-Schedule: The competition will start on Thursday, January 29 and will be finished on Sunday, February 1. Some participants may arrive on Wednesday January 28 and the departure of some may be on Sunday 1th, depending of the dates of their specific events. A detailed Time-Schedule will be sent to all participating ISU Members and Clubs soon after the deadline of entries.

(min. 8 revs, variations possible but no change of foot and no flying entrance!!!)

1 combination-spin with or without change of foot

(min. 1 change of position, 8 revs without and 5/5 revs with change of foot, no flying entrance)

1 spin of free choice (must be different of the others)

1 step sequence of free choice (no spirals!)

(min. 1 change of position, 8 revs without and 5/5 revs with change of foot, no flying entrance)

Music

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD, MD or DAT format. In accordance with Rule 343 all cassettes and discs must show the Competition event, Competitors name, the Nation and the exact running time of the music, and must be submitted at the time of registration.

Planned Program Sheet

Attached "Planned Program Sheets" have to be filled out precisely and must return together with the entry forms to the Organizing Committee in time.

Accreditation

The official accreditation is at the main entrance of the Ice Rink.
Accreditation will be given to all Competitors, Judges, Coaches and Guests.

Results

The calculation of results will be done according to ISU Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating 2008, Rule 353.

Awards

The first three best placed competitors and couples in each event will be awarded by Medals or Trophies, there will be Diplomas for all participants.
