GENERAL RULES

Amadé Cup 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the Austrian regulations (ÖWO 2025 and Richtlinie für Wettbewerbe 2025/2026), ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations 2024 and Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2024 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications (2025-2026). The teams must belong to a member club of an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 7), the ages must fall within the limits specified in Rule 108. All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102.

The final results will be determined according to Rules 738-741 and the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2024.

ENTRIES

Entries are not limited, but according to the number of Entries for Amadé Cup, the competition might be extended to January 23rd or 24th. This information will be provided by October 15th 2025.

The preliminary entries must reach the Organizer by latest:

October 1, 2025 by submitting the preliminary entry form by email to oc@mozartcup.com

After October 1, 2025 all clubs that submitted the preliminary entries will receive the link to the online entry system.

Final Entries by name must be submitted **not later than December 19, 2025**.

ACCREDITATION

The **accreditation** for Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data/Replay Operators, Teams, Accredited Coaches, Team Leaders and Team Managers will take place at **Eisarena Salzburg on Thursday, January 22, 2026 from 08:00 to 18:00.**

On Friday and Saturday the accreditation will be at the OC-Office at Eisarena Salzburg open during practice and competition times.

All registered skaters have to enclose a **copy of their passport** when they sign in, passport copies have to be collected for the referee of the competition!

ENTRY FEES

The Entry fee for Amadé Cup 2026 will be

Please note: Entry fees do not include extra practice ice or other additional costs.

TECHNICAL AND JUDGES PANEL

The Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators will be nominated by the Organizing Committee have at least national qualification for Synchronized Skating 2025/26.

Clubs can nominate judges with at least national qualification, a confirmation of the national federation about their qualification must be attached.

The Organizer will cover the travel expenses for invited Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators only. Ordered flight tickets should be based on economy airfare. The Organizer will provide ground transportation for invited Technical Panel, the Referees and nominated Judges. The expenses (room and meals) for invited Technical Panel, the Referees and nominated Judges will be borne by the Organizer starting with Dinner Saturday January 24 2026 till breakfast Monday January 26.

Spouses and other persons accompanying teams are not included. All other expenses shall be the responsibility of each official.

The Draw for the Panel of Judges will be done after the Entry Deadline and the respective member federations will be informed.

TECHNICAL RULES

The **Amadé Cup 2026** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Amadé Cup 2026** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 4.

The Free Skating Elements and Requirements to be skated for Season 2025/26 are listed in the relevant ISU Communication for Season 2025/26.

Amadécup:

Age requirements: 75% of the Team must fulfill the age requirements

Adult

Shall consist of 8-16 skaters (4 alternates), these must have reached the age of 21 before July 1st 2025

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (± 10 seconds)

Mixed Age

Shall consist of 10-16 skaters (4 alternates)

Free Skating Program: 3:30 minutes (± 10 seconds)

Juvenile

Shall consist of 8-16 skaters (4 alternates), these should not have reached the age of thirteen (13) before July 1st 2025.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (± 10 seconds)

Elements: like Basic Novice, maximum level that can be reached is Level 2, except for SySp, where it is max. Level 1.

Non ISU Basic Novice

shall consist of 8-16 skaters (4 alternates), these should not have reached the age of sixteen (16) before July 1st 2025.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes ($\pm$ 10 seconds)
Elements: like ISU Basic Novice

The layout of the arena with the entrance to and exit from the ice, judge's stand, etc. will be forwarded to each participant approximately one month before competition.

MUSIC

All teams shall provide their competition music of excellent quality.

Teams arriving in Austria by coach will be independent (parking lot at the Ice-rink).

If you need any help in finding transportation, please contact the OC oc@mozartcup.com. The Organizing Committee grants the transportation of the invited Technical Panel, Referees and Judges from/to Salzburg Airport or Railway Station. Please try to find flights to Salzburg!

ICE RINK

The "**Eisarena Salzburg**" is located at Hermann-Bahr-Promenade 2, almost in the center of Salzburg. Easy to be reached: 20 minutes by car from Salzburg Airport, 10 minutes by car from the Railway Station.

"Eisarena Salzburg" has a capacity of 3.200 seats. The ice surface is 30 x 60 m, artificial and the arena will be heated during the competition.

EXTRA PRACTICE ICE

The official practice will start on Sunday, January 25, 2026. Each team will be allowed a 10-minute period of official practice ice for the Free, free of charge. No extra practice ice will be available after the Official Draw. For extra practice ice reservation, send an Email to oc@mozartcup.com (Wednesday, January 21, and Thursday, January 22, 2026) by **latest December 26, 2025**.

DRAW

The draw will be done electronically and published online by latest 48 hours before the start of the respective category.

AWARDS

Medals will be presented to all participating skaters.

LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, Austrian Figure Skating Federation and the Organizing Committee for the competition accept no liability for injury or damage sustained by competitors or officials. The Organizing Committee will not be providing participant insurance coverage for the event. Each Member is expected to provide its own insurance protection. The Organizing Committee will provide emergency medical services for all participants during the competition and official practice.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Each team manager should be able to give important medical information for each skater for use in case of an emergency or accident.

Such information should include but is not limited to the following, and will greatly help local medical and emergency personnel:

- allergies
- existing medical conditions (i.e. asthma)
- current medications
- immunizations
- blood type
- use of glasses, contact lenses, dental appliances

PUBLICITY WAIVER

Each individual and/or team waive any and all rights to financial remuneration or other compensation for the use or reproduction of their image or likeness, or that of their synchronized skating team, and grant permission to use same, as or in publicity prior to, during or following the Mozart Cup, in Salzburg, Austria.

TICKETS

Each participating team will be provided with 6 free passes – Team Manager, Coach, Assistant Coach, Medical Person, two (2) Team Service Personnel and one (1) for Team Leader – per participating ISU Member.

If Teams want to watch the ISU Mozartcup, they can purchase tickets for a reduced price by sending an email to oc@mozartcup.com by latest January 18, 2025, which will be only valid with the Amadécup accreditations.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

Deadline for “Program Content Sheet” is December 19, 2025. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet is filled through the online Entry System precisely by each team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the Scale of Value Table published in ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2024 as well as in all pertinent ISU Communications. The Planned Program Content Sheet must be signed by a coach or Team Representative.
