ANNOUNCEMENT

The French Figure Skating Association and Club Olympique de Courbevoie are pleased to announce Rooster Cup 2009, the International Competition in Figure Skating for Novice Ladies/Men, Chick Ladies/Men, and Cub Ladies/Men.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted in accordance with Constitution and General Regulations 2008, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2008 and ISU Communication for n°1397, as well as pertinents ISU Communications.

TECHNICAL DATA

1. **International Novices** = + 10 years old on july 1st 2008
- 15 years old on july 1st 2008

Short and Free Programs : Technical Rules Novices ISU **communication n° 1397**.

2. **Chicks** = - 10 years old on july 1st 2008

Free Skating Program of 3:00 minutes for girls and boys :

- a) Maximum of 6 jump elements one which must be an Axel type and there may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination can contain three (3) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- b) There must be a maximum of three (3) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum of ten (10) revolutions) and one a spin with only one position (minimum of six (6) revolutions). In spins the minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted. Number of changes of foot in the spin combination is optional.
- c) A maximum of 1 step sequence or 1 spiral sequence.

Coefficient = Men : 2 Ladies : 1,6

3. **Cubs** = - 8 years old on july 1st 2008

Free Skating Program of 2:30 minutes for girls and boys :

- a) Maximum of 5 jump elements one which must be a Lutz type and there may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination can contain three (3) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum of eight (8) revolutions and change of foot is optionnel) and one a spin with only one position (minimum of six (6) revolutions). In spins the minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted. Number of changes of foot in the spin combination is optional.
- c) A maximum of 1 step sequence or 1 spiral sequence.

Coefficient = Men : 2 Ladies : 1,6

Deductions = 0,5 by fall

ENTRIES

Entries must reach the organizer not later than March 20th 2009.

Entries of Competitors and nominations of judges, specialists or controllers must be made by the National Associations on the designated form.

The Club Olympique de Courbevoie reserves the right to limit the number of Competitors and Judges.

OPENING DRAW

The opening draw will take place on Thursday, April 30th at 16.00 in the club house of ice rink.

AWARDS

The three best competitors of each event will be awarded with cups. All competitors will receive a medal.

ANTI DOPING

Anti doping tests may be carried out in accordance with the valid ISU anti doping code (ISU communications n° 1546 and 1547 or any further update of the communication) and French Ministry.

LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119 the Organizer accepts no liability for injuries or damages incurred by Competitors or Officials. The Organizer will provide Medical Emergency Aid during the Competition.

PRE OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Practice ice is available by special appointment at a cost of EUR 15,00 per hour and per skater. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.
