Content of entry:

1. name of the event and category

2. Categories

Minis Age group 5 und younger

Age: competitors born after 01.07.2004

The skaters shall presents required elements to music. The order of elements and the pattern are obligatory. The results be done by OBO system (6,0 system). The marks are valued like in Short program.

Required elements:

- 1 circle chassee forward or forward crossovers
- 1 circle chassee backward or backward crossovers
- forward stroking (half of the track) and forward arabesque on one foot and a stop
- forward stroking in the opposite direction and Shoot the duck

Minis Age group 6

Age: competitors born between 01.07.2003-30.06.2004

The skaters present required elements to music. The order of elements and the pattern are obligatory. The results be done by OBO system (6,0 system). The marks are valued like in Short Program.

Obligatory elements:

- forward crossovers Eight (2 circels on each foot)
- forward stroking into squat or shoot the duck (ca. 10m) change into forward arabesque (5 m)
- backward crossovers (2 circels)
- jump of own choise
- upright spin (3 revolutions are required, two or one footed) – bonus for sit spin
- jump of own choise (no repetition)

Beginners Age group 7 and younger

Age: competitors born after 01.07.2002

The results be done by NJS. numbers of elements: 9

- 6 or 7 jump elements (allowed are 3 combinations or sequences, one of these shall consist of three jumps). Any type of jump is only three times permitted.
- 1 or 2 different spins
- 1 step or spiral sequence (spirals are only for girls permitted)

components:

- skating skills: 0,8
- transitions: 0,6
- performance / execution: 0,8
- choreography: 0,5
- interpretation: 0,6

duration of music: 2.30 min ±10 sec

Beginners Age group 8

Age: competitors born between 01.07.2001 and 30.06.2002

The results be done by NJS. number of elements: 10

- 6 or 7 jump elements (allowed are 3 combinations or sequences, one of these shall consist of three jumps). Any type of jump is only three times permitted.
- 2 or 3 different spins of different groups
- 1 step or spiral sequence (spirals are only for girls permitted)

components:

- skating skills: 1,0
- transitions: 0,75
- performance / execution: 1,0
- choreography: 0,5
- interpretation: 0,75

duration of program: 3.00 min ±10 sec (no deductions for shorter programs)

Beginners Age group 9

Age: competitors born between 01.07.2000 and 30.06.2001

The results be done by NJS. number of elements: 10

- 6 or 7 jump elements (allowed are 3 combinations or sequences, one of these shall consist of three jumps). Any type of jump is only three times permitted.
- 2 or 3 different spins of different groups
- 1 step or spiral sequence (spirals are only for girls permitted)

components:

- skating skills: 1,0
- transitions: 0,75
- performance / execution: 1,0
- choreography: 0,5
- interpretation: 0,75

duration of program: 3.00 min ±10 sec (no deductions for shorter programs)

Beginners Age group 10

Age: competitors born between 01.07.1999 and 30.06.2000

The results be done by NJS. number of elements: 10

- 6 or 7 jump elements (allowed are 3 combinations or sequences, one of these shall consist of three jumps). Any type of jump is only three times permitted.
- 2 or 3 different spins of different groups
- 1 step or spiral sequence (spirals are only for girls permitted)

components:

- skating skills: 1,0
- transitions: 0,75
- performance / execution: 1,0
- choreography: 0,5
- interpretation: 0,75

duration of program: 3.00 min $\pm$ 10 sec (no deductions for shorter programs)

Novice Age group 12 years and younger

Age at 01.07.2009: maximum age 12 years; minimum age 9 years

Content: free program accordance to the ISU Communication Nr. 1397. The results be done by NJS.

Novice Age group 14 years and younger
