PLACE AND DATE

The competition will be held on November 30th and 1st, 2018 in Eindhoven, the Netherlands. All competition events will take place at the indoor figure skating ice rink (60x30 m) at the ice sport center, Eindhoven.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRY

November 10th 2019, 23:59h

ACCREDITATION

Will be possible on Saturday November 30st from approx. 07.00h on at the ice rink.

PRACTICE SESSION

There is a practice session available for international entries only on Friday the 29th of November, from 18.00-19.00h. Please contact the competition secretary if you would like to subscribe one or more skaters (first come, first serve). Practice session fees are 10,- € per skater.

DRAW

Will be applied to all categories by a computer generated system producing the starting order.

Will be made available on the website/facebook page as soon as possible after the closing date. Changes may occur due to technical requirements of the judging system and/or exceeding number of entries.

JUDGES AND/OR TECHNICAL SPECIALISTS

For international entries; please inform the organizing committee in case you are considering adding a judge and/or technical specialist to the competition. These request will then be made known to the Dutch Skating Federation. All categories will be judged with the ISU judging system.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted in accordance with ISU Regulations 2018 and all recent communications for figure skating (single skating). All categories abide to regulations according to the ISU judging system and will be judged as such. All competitors must be eligible persons in accordance with ISU Rule 102, provided their age falls within limits specified in Rule 108. All competitors must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in ISU Rule 109. All skaters who do not have nationality of the member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another member, must produce an ISU clearance certificate.

COMPETITION

MUSIC

Only CDs are accepted (no re-writable CD or mp3). The recording must be of good quality and the CD labeled clearly with the name of the competitor, category and skating club/country abbreviations. The CD (or CDs) must be handed in at the accreditation desk on first arrival. The CD quality cannot be tested beforehand, therefore a second copy should always be made available for technical staff in case a technical issue should arise during the competition. The organisation will not be held responsible in case of music distortion or malfunctioning of the CD.

PRIZES

Each of the winning competitors will be presented with a trophy. Also, during the victory ceremony all competitors are invited to be on the ice in order to receive a memento. The protocol will be uploaded on the homepage immediately after the closing of the competition. Club members or coaches are allowed to collect trophies that belong to the participants that were forced to leave early before the completion of the victory ceremony.

ACCOMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

Accommodation as well as transportation from and to the ice rink has to be organized by the participant. However, please feel free to contact our organizing committee with any questions. The organizing committee holds no liability for injuries or damage sustained by competitors on any competition day.

ENTRY FORM

For international entries, please use the official entry form.

LIMITATIONS

The organization is adhering to decisions made by the Dutch Skating Union (dep. of figure skating) for competitions in season 2019-2020.

The organization committee reserves the right to limit entries for all categories. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis; up to the maximum in relation to the available competition hours. The organizing club will follow the order mentioned by the clubs on their entry form. Following rules of entry apply to all participating clubs:

- Every club has the right to enter a maximum of **3** skaters in each category (Boys & Girls). In addition, every club may register **3** skaters as back-up, please enter these skaters under header 'substitute'. These skaters may only replace the original entry for the competition before the results of the first draw or can be added by the organizing club only in case the competition schedule allows more entries overall.
- The organizing club has the right to enter an unlimited number of participants in all categories.

ENTRANCE FEE

The payment must be made in full by November 15th. No refunds can be given.

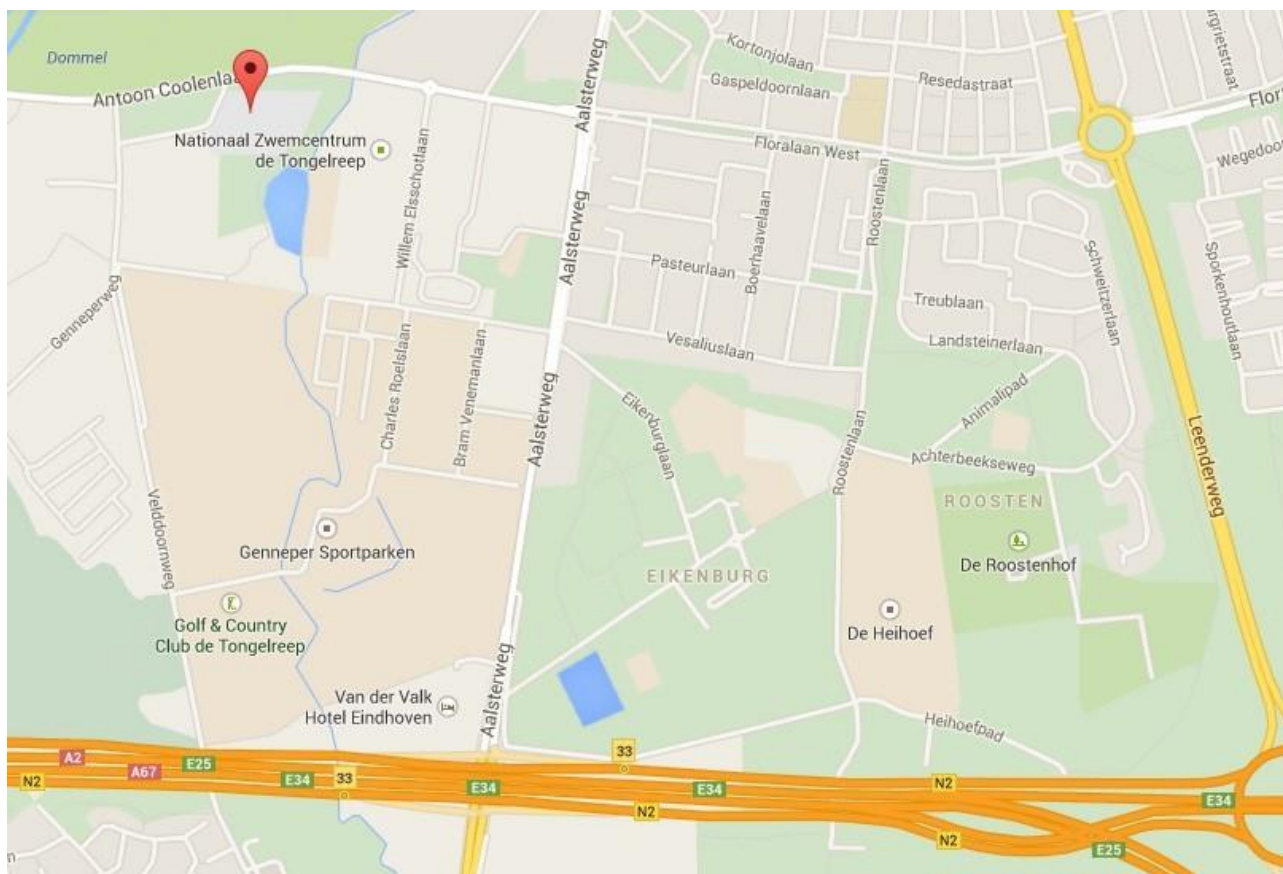
No charges for the beneficiary. No cheques will be accepted. Payments made after the proposed date will result in an additional administration fee of 10,- € per skater.
