Dear Ladies/Sirs, we are pleased to send you an invitation to our annual Figure Skating Competition in Stockholm, Sweden. After three years with no Inter Club competition in Stockholm we are happy to invite you once again. This competition is sanctioned by the Swedish Figure Skating Association.

Organizer: **Boo SK**

Date: **2 – 5 March 2017**

Place of competition: **Nacka Ice Rink (30 x 60 m), heated**

Entries:

All ISU members and clubs, members of National Figure Skating Federations associated to ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants in case the number of competitors is too high. The organizing club reserves the right to enter more competitors. The clubs are asked to list the skaters in the order in which they wish to be accepted to the competition. We will divide the categories into smaller groups according to age if necessary.

Categories:

JUNIOR A, ladies, age and requirement according to ISU

Short program and Free program

JUNIOR B, ladies age according to ISU

Free program, 3 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE A, boys and girls age and requirements according to ISU

Short program and Free program

BASIC NOVICE A, girls born 1/7 2003-30/6 2006, requirements according to ISU

Competition only in Free programs, 3 min +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE B, girls, born 1/7 2001-30/6 2003, requirements according to ISU

Competition only in Free program, 3 min +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE BOYS, born 1/7 2003-30/6 2006, requirements according to ISU

Competition free skating only, 3 min +/- 10 sec

SPRINGS A, girls born 1/7 2001-30/6 2003

Competition only in Free program, 3 min +/- 10 sec

SPRINGS B, girls born 1/7 2003-30/6 2005

Competition only in Free program, 3 min +/- 10 sec

SPRINGS C, girls born 1/7 2003-30/6 2005

Competition only in Free program, 3 min +/- 10 sec

CUBS A, boys and girls born 1/7 2005 and younger

Competition only in Free program, 2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

CUBS B, girls born 1/7 2005 and younger

Competition only in Free program, 2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

CUBS C, girls born 1/7 2005 and younger

Competition only in Free program, 2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

Evaluation: All categories ISU Judging System

Judges: Each invited member or club with entries in at least three categories may suggest one International Judge or ISU Judge. The organizer reserves the right to select the judges. Accommodation and meals will be paid for the selected judges by the organizer.

Deadline for entries: All entries (competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches) are expected to be Emailed and received at organizer's address not later than **February 1**. Enclosed entry form must be used. OC: Pia Pettersson, E-mail stockholmtrophy@gmail.com

Expenses: The organizer covers the expenses of competition, awards and presents. Transfer expenses to and from Stockholm and accommodation will not be covered by the organizer. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

Liability: The organizing committee accepts no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury, property loss or damage suffered by the competitors or officials during the competition. According to ISU rule 119.

Language: The official language is English

Music: Music will be reproduced from CD or mp3 files. CD must be of good quality and state the full name of the competitor, category, name of club and country.

Calculation of results: ISU judging system in all categories.

Awards: The three best placed competitors in each category will be awarded special presents, all others diplomas. Victory ceremony for the podium will be held on ice if nothing else is stated by the OC.

Charges: SEK 600 is to be paid for each competitor in categories with only free skating and SEK 800 for categories with short + free IJS. Payment must be made in advance no later than **February 24**

Information summary:

1. Office of Organizing Committee will be located in the Ice Rink and will be at your disposal from Thursday 2 March morning to Sunday 5 March evening, during the competition and practice time. Registration at the office upon arrival is mandatory for all participants.
2. Deadline for entries: February 1. Planned Program Content form must be sent in by February 24. That is for all categories.
3. Payment of entry fee must be made no later than February 24, 2017. The entry fee will be partially refunded only if a medical certificate can be presented. After the draw there will be no refunding of the fee. Draw for all categories: Wednesday 1 March evening at 20.00.
4. Detailed time schedule for the competition will be sent out with the confirmation. Depending on the number of participants we might have to adjust the preliminary schedule. Schedule for practice ice will also be sent out with confirmation.
5. The organizer can not arrange transportation to and from airport, boat and hotel for participants.
