1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The International ICE Dance Dordrecht will be conducted following the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 and the relevant subsequent ISU Communications and updates.

Participation in the International ICE Dance Dordrecht competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

All entries must be submitted through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the Member Federations.

Passports and ISU Clearance Certificates (if applicable) must be presented at accreditation.

 - **Intermediate Novice Ice Dance**
 - **Basic Novice Ice Dance**
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4. TECHNICAL DATA

Rule 709, paragraph 1. a) provides that rhythm(s) and/or theme(s) are selected by the Ice Dance Technical Committee annually for the season. For the season 2025/26,

Senior Ice Dance

- **Rhythm Dance**
Duration: 2 minutes 50 seconds +/- 10 seconds
- **Free Dance**
Duration: 4 min. ± 10 sec

Junior Ice Dance

ICE DANCE Requirements for Technical Rules season 2025/26 rule 709, 710 and Communication No. 2704 or following subsequent updates:

- **Rhythm Dance**
Duration: 2 minutes 50 seconds +/- 10 seconds
- **Free Dance**
Duration: 3 min. 30 sec. ± 10 sec

Novice Categories Ice Dance

For all categories the following applies. GUIDELINES FOR INTERNATIONAL NOVICE COMPETITIONS 2025/26 and [Communication No. 2700](#) or following subsequent communications. Rule 707, provides that, in International Competitions, the current series of ISU Ice Dance music shall be used for the Pattern Dance unless the Ice Dance Technical Committee has decided that the music for one or several Pattern Dances is to be provided by the Couple, following certain requirements. For season 2025/26, Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

BASIC NOVICE

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated from the following season 25/26. These will be drawn before the first practice on site:

- Willow Waltz, Tango Canasta and Rhythm Blues

Free dance: 2 minutes (+/- 10 seconds)

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated from the following season 25/26. These will be drawn before the first practice on site:

- Rocker Foxtrot, European Waltz, Tango

Free dance: 2 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 seconds)

ADVANCED NOVICE

two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated from the following season 25/26. These will be drawn before the first practice on site:

- Starlight, Waltz and Quickstep
- Duration of the Quickstep Pattern Dance (2) sequences and one (1) Choreographic Element must be completed within one 1 minute 10 seconds.

Fee dance: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds)

5. ENTRIES and FEES

Entries: All Entries must be made by the ISU Member concerned based on the regulations for ISU in Figure Skating 2024/25. All entries for the International Ice Dance Dordrecht, must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the deadline indicated.

Travel information should also be entered into ORS:

Registration deadline: July 28, 2025.

Each ISU Member can enter up to three (3) couples in each category. In case of too many entries, the organizer may reduce the final entries.

- All entries must be submitted via the **ISU ORS system**.

- A reserve list will be maintained if necessary due to high demand.

MUSIC & PROGRAM CONTENT

All music must be submitted **in MP3 format** before the entry deadline. File naming convention: **<Category>_<Segment:RD/FD>_<Nation>_<Names>_<Duration>**

Each couple must also bring a **USB backup**.

Planned Program Content must be submitted in English using official ISU terminology, and uploaded through the ORS system

- **Late entry fee € 185 per Ice Dance couple after July 28, 2025**

6. JUDGES

Each participating ISU Member may nominate:

- One **International or ISU Judge**
- One **substitute Judge** (optional)

The OC reserves the right to draw from the pool of nominated Judges.

The Panels will be drawn after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw. The Panel of Judges for Novice, Junior and Senior will be composed as determined by the relevant ISU Communications.

The organizer covers the costs of travel and accommodation and full board for the event officials.

7. PRACTICE & DRAW

Official practice starts Saturday August 16 8am and Sunday August 17 8am.

The detailed training schedule will be available after the final list of participants is confirmed.

- The draw will be held **Friday evening**, August 8.
 - The starting order for Free Dance will follow the **reverse order** of Rhythm Dance results.

8. RESULTS

Results will be calculated using the **ISU Judging System**, in accordance with Rule 352 and Rule 353.

9. AWARDS

- **Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals** will be awarded to the top 3 couples in each category.
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10. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

Each participating ISU Member or the participants individually are responsible for providing **medical and accident insurance** for all athletes, officials, and team members, in accordance with ISU Rule 119.

The Organizing Committee **accepts no liability** for personal injury or property loss.
