THE CITY

Location

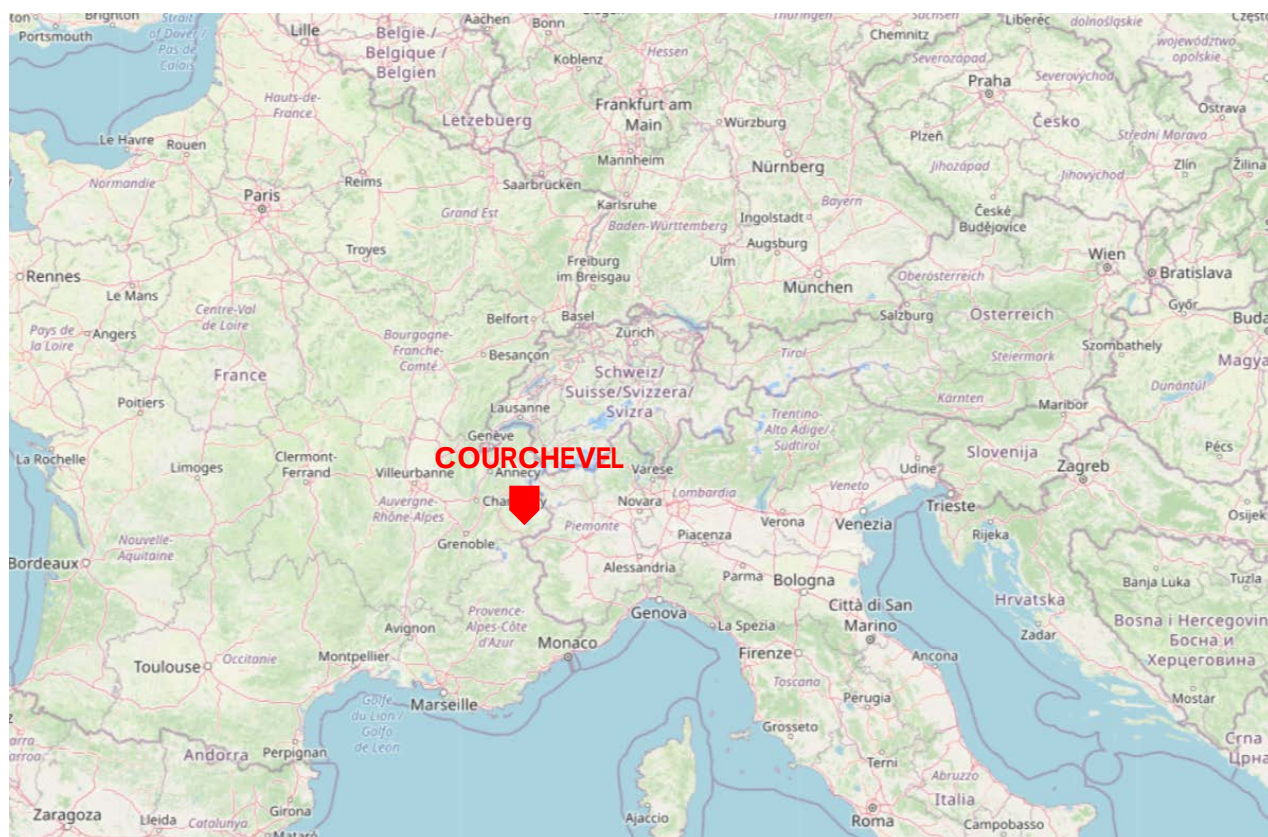
Courchevel is a Ski Winter Sport Tarentaise Valley, located in the municipality of Saint-Bon-Tarentaise and La Perrière, in the Savoie's department, France. It has an estimated population of 2365 inhabitants as of 2019 and has 400 km² of ski area, which is one of the largest ski area in the world.

The resort of Courchevel spans five levels around different villages: Saint-Bon (1150 meters altitude), La Praz (1300m), Courchevel Village (1550m), Courchevel Moriond (1650m) and Courchevel (1850m). It is the first resort in the country equipped with greenfield site in 1946 on the territory of the municipality of Saint-Bon-Tarentaise.

Courchevel has always been an international reference in the landscape of winter sports as it hosted the 1992 Albertville Olympic Games and often welcomes the  Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating in its prestigious Olympic ice-rink « Forum », which is also used for Ice Hockey games.

THE VILLAGES AND SKI RESORTS

The Praz' Springboards

These ski springboards were built in 1990 to welcome, two years later, the Olympic Winter Games 1992 held at Albertville. It annually hosts the Grand Prix Summer Ski Jumping.



Les Trois Vallées – The Three Valleys

With 600 kilometers of slopes, the Valley is the largest ski area in the world and is renowned for its accessibility for all levels (from easy trails to harder ones with 111 red and 30 black runs). Les Trois Vallées has 183 ski lifts, which can transport 260,000 skiers per hour.

Furthermore, it is not only a record-breaking ski area but also an amazing place for epicureans with a total of 19 Michelin stars and 11 gastronomic restaurants to enjoy the high-quality local specialties.

Built in 1967, the Olympic Ice-Rink Forum, which has been brought up to date with new equipment, is ready to welcome the numerous junior talents of figure skating, the spectators, the International Skating Union (ISU) as well as its partners for a memorable sport event.

GENERAL ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION

Reservations

Every hotel reservation can only be made through the Organizing Committee (OC) by submitting a request via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS).

In the event that rooms reservations are to be **cancelled after August 9th**, any cancellation fees the OC will receive will be invoiced to the Member Federation.

Payment

The OC will cover the costs for accommodating the **Athletes, Judges, Referees, ISU Event Team and other Officials** in accordance with the ISU Junior Grand Prix Memorandum, its appendixes, and the ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating 2022 Courchevel Announcement. The OC is not required to cover the expenses of other category of people of the Members. Therefore, the Members will be sent invoices prior to the start of the event. In case of non-payment, the OC would have to cancel your hotel reservation for the Junior Grand Prix and be saddened not to welcome you for this special sport event.

The Members will be sent invoices prior to the start of the event and payment will have to be made **no later than August 14th**.



MEALS

BREAKFAST AT THE HOTELS' RESTAURANT

Breakfast will take place at each hotel's restaurant and is included with the hotel reservation made in ORS.

LUNCH & DINNER AT THE ICE RINK

Lunch and dinner will take place at the ice-rink's restaurant (official dining room) for those covered by the OC. Individual meals for lunch and dinner may be purchased on-site outside the dining room during dining room hours. For more information, please check the general information below.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The OC will provide and cover the expenses for meals for all Competitors, Judges and ISU Event Officials participating, beginning with dinner on Tuesday, August 23, 2022 until breakfast on Sunday, August 28, 2022.

Skaters, Judges and ISU Event Officials will receive at registration their meal vouchers for the event which allows them to access the ice-rink restaurant. Drink vouchers for Judges and ISU Event Officials will be given to the respective person upon accreditation.

Additional individual meal vouchers for lunch and dinner, as well as drink tickets, will be available for purchase on-site, outside the dining room, during dining room hours, for other Team Members.

TRANSPORTATION

TRAVELLING TO COURCHEVEL

By Plane:

The nearest international airport to Courchevel is Lyon Saint Exupery (LYS) with a distance of 190 km to the official hotel, corresponding to up to 3 hours by shuttle from the airport to the official hotels.

Shuttle Service from/to the Airport:

The OC will welcome all official Team Members, Referees, Judges, Event Officials, and other Officials at their Terminal and escort them to the Ice Rink for accreditation and then to their hotels with a shuttle bus, provided that the detailed travel information was given to the OC through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS).

The name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival should be submitted as soon as possible and **no later than Friday, July 22, 2022 on the ORS**. The participants and teams should also inform the OC whether they will be using the transportation offered (pick-up service).

Please understand that a small transportation fee from all persons participating in this shuttle service will be asked. The fee for the pick-up service is 60€ per person for a one-way ride. In total, the two-way ride pick-up service equals 120€ per person (one for the arrival from the airport to the official hotels and one for the return from the official hotels) and should be paid to the OC **no later than August 14th**.

VISA APPLICATION

The Government of France requires that all travellers carry a valid passport as the only universally accepted travel and identification document for the purposes of international travel if you are from outside the European Union. If you are from the European Union, the ID card can be used for traveling.

Processing for visa application vary depending on the visa and the time of the year. Participants are encouraged to apply approximately **6 to 12 weeks** in advance of their departure date to ensure they receive the visa in time.

EVENT SHUTTLE

Shuttle Service from the Official Hotels to the Venue:

A shuttle bus service between the hotels and the rink will be provided by the OC free of charge for the Competitors, Team Members, and ISU Officials.

A detail schedule will be available on the ISU Events app and will also be given at registration. It will also be displayed in each hotel and be available at the Information & Transportation desk in the Venue.

The only persons entitled to the OC shuttle bus service are the Competitors, Team Members, Judges, Referees, Technical Panel, and other ISU Officials. Chaperons are also allowed a bus permit.

Passport copies:

Skaters must present their passport to be verified and copied by the OC before they receive an accreditation at the accreditation's station. The registration for all teams will be held at the ice rink upon arrivals.

SECURITY

Accreditations passes will be issued for identification and security purposes. Therefore, please make sure to always wear your ID-card, otherwise you will not be granted passage into the Venue.

ELECTRICITY

The electric current is 220 volts AC, 50 Hertz. European two-pin plugs are required or bring plug converters from home.

CURRENCY

The official domestic currency is the Euro (€).

Banking Hours

Most banks are open Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 18:00. Most of them are closed during the weekends but some are open for a short amount of time on Saturday morning.

Money exchange

Foreign currency can be exchanged at the airport, banks and exchange offices.
