ANNOUNCEMENT / INVITATION

SKF Iceskater and GKS Stocznowiec have the pleasure to invite the ISU Members to participate in 1st Christmas Event. The competition will be re-recorded virtual competition, with streaming on 20 December 2020 in Gdansk, Poland.

JUDGES, REFEREE AND TECHNICAL PANEL:

The Competition will be judged under the ISU system. Panel of Judges for each competition will consist of:

- 1 Referee,
- 5 Judges,
- 1 Technical Controller,
- 1 Technical Specialists,
- 1 Assistant Technical Specialist,
- 1 Data/Replay operator.

Scores will be show during the stream and displayed after program. Some of the Judges and the Technical Panel will be on the ice rink as on normal competitions, and some will be online.

TECHNICAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1st Christmas Event will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations 2018 and Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2018 as well as applicable ISU Communications. The teams must belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 7). All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102 and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109.

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Pre-Juvenile: The free program of the category Pre-Juvenile will be according to the rules of the Basic Novice. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who have not reached the age of 11 by 1 July 2020 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

- Free Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2238 Basic Novice Free Skating Program. Teams may attempt any level but the highest level that will be called for an element will be one level lower than the highest level.

Advanced Novice: The free program of the category Basic Novice will be according to the rules of the Basic Novice. Shall consist of 16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 10 but have not reached the age of 15 by 1 July 2020

- Free Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2238 Basic Novice Free Skating Program. Teams may attempt any level but the highest level that will be called for an element will be one level lower than the highest level.



Junior B teams: The free program of the category Junior B will be according to the rules of the Junior. Shall consist of 12-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 13 but have not reached the age of 19 by 1 July 2020 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

- Free Skating Program: 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/-10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2236 Junior Free Skating Program.

Junior: according to ISU regulations shall consist of 16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 13 but have not reached the age of 19 before the 1st July 2020

- Short Program: maximum 2 minutes 50 seconds, Factor 0.8.
- Free Skating Program: 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/-10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2236 Junior Short Program and Junior Free Skating Program.

Senior: according to ISU regulations shall consist of 16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 15 before the 1st July 2020.

- Short Program: maximum 2 minutes 50 seconds, Factor 0.8
- Free Skating Program: 4 minutes (+/-10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2236 Senior Short Program and Senior Free Skating Program.

Mixed Age: The free program of the category Mixed Age will be according to the rules of the Mixed Age. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates. No age limit.

- Free Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2236 Mixed Age Free Skating Program.
- Valuts and Lifts are permitted.

Adult: The free program of the category Adult will be according to the rules of Technical Requirements Season 2020/21 for International Adult Figure Skating & Adult Synchronized Skating Competitions. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 18 by 1 July 2020. Factor 1.6.

Video Requirements

Camera Position:

- The camera must be elevated and if possible situated close to 6 rows, close to where a Technical Panel would be seated, approximately at centre ice,
- The camera must remain in one place and remain stationary during the recording,
- It is important to keep all Skaters in view at all times. Of course for some elements, such as Angled Intersection, one side of ice rink can be recorded.
- If recording with a phone please use the landscape orientation,
- Please do not use the camera zoom.

Video Format:

Video files should have format MP4.

Quality Standards

High resolution videos are best (720p or 1080p when possible).

It is important to use the original video downloaded to make your clips.
