WELCOME

The Organizing committee reserves the right to change the date, location, and program of the competition. When submitting an entry all competitors acknowledge that due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and public health issues the Organizers can only host the competition in accordance with the effective medical and government regulations and has the solemn right to cancel the competition at any time or to host it between closed doors with a limited number of competitors and no spectators. The competitors also acknowledge that in case laws forbid it the Organizers are unable to hold the competition. Furthermore, in case the competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues the Organizers bear no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the Organizers. The Organizers are not obliged to assign a new date for the competition if it is cancelled because of the abovementioned reasons. The competitors acknowledge that upon cancellation of the competition they do not have the right to claim back the already paid entry fee as the Organizers had various costs concerning the competition.

GENERAL RULES

Sebestyén Cup 2022 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in Sebestyén Cup 2022 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in this Announcement and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it.

EUROPEAN CRITERIUM TROPHY

Sebestyén Cup is associated with the European Criterium Tournament 2021/22 for Junior, Novice, Cubs and Chicks categories. Results of the Teams will count for competition of International Trophy of Figure Skating European Criterium. Individual points are automatically calculated for all skaters in every category and those are valid in the European Criterium Tournament in the same category. The age requirements and the special regulation for the European Criterium Trophy are published on the website of the EC: www.europeancriterium.eu

Categories: Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice, Cubs, Mini Cubs, Chicks, Mini Chicks

Place of competition: Budapest Practice Rink (H-1146 Budapest, Istvánmezei út 3-5.) Rink is indoor, heated ice rink with a surface of 60 x 30 meters, located near the centre of Budapest.

CUBS I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2011 – 30.6.2012

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CUBS II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2012 – 30.6.2013

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CUBS BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2011 – 30.6.2013

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a)** Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. Only two (2) jumps can be repeated in a jump combination or jump sequence. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b)** There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c)** There must be a maximum:
 - for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
 - for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The factors of the Program Components are

- Boys 2.5
- Girls 2.5

LEVELS EXPLANATIONS

For Cubs and Mini Cubs Singles, in all elements, which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

CHICKS I. GIRLS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2013 – 30.6.2014

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS II. GIRLS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2014 and younger.

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS BOYS

Age requirements: Skaters born: 1.7.2013 and younger

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. Only two (2) jumps can be repeated in a jump combination or jump sequence. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum:
 - for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

The factors of the Program Components are

- Boys 2.5
- Girls 2.5

LEVELS EXPLANATIONS

For Chicks ISU 7 and younger Singles, in all elements, which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS

All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System. The results and any additional information for the event will be published on the websites www.europeancriterium.eu

ENTERING THE CONTEST

Entries for Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice, Cubs, Mini Cubs, Chicks, Mini Chicks categories (*Interclub competition*) will be accepted only by clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU.

Each club may enter 2 competitors in each category (2 males and 2 females). The organizing club takes right to enter more competitors.

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants. The maximum entries accepted will be approximately 30 in each category.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

Each participant must send to web administrator www.europeancriterium.eu request for code direct online registration and realize the entry not later (deadline for entries) **than March 17th 2022.**

The entries for the competition will be held via web portal europeancriterimu.eu. Before entry procedure association/club representative need to apply for new account on www.europeancriterium.eu/Account/Register.

Organizers of the European Criterium website are committed to the proper protection of personal data in accordance with the European Union GDPR Regulation. Therefore, in the context of Privacy Policy, is require appropriate consent in the applications. Without this, the entries for European Criterium competitions can not possible in the future.

PAYMENTS

Entry fee is **50 EUR per skater** for the categories Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice, Cubs, Mini Cubs, Chicks, Mini Chicks. The entry fee must be paid for each competitor at the Registration before the competition.

CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry, if any, has to be done till **March 24th 2022** with e-mail to organizer. For any later cancellation the team leader or any representative of Club will be asked to pay the entry fee.

JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

Each participating ISU Member may enter Judges for the event. ISU Championships, International Judges and National will be accepted. However, the OC reserves the right to limit the number of judges in accordance with the number of the Skaters' Entries.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators and confirmed Judges at, **HOTEL LIONS GARDEN** beginning with dinner on Wednesday March 31th 2022 until lunch on Sunday, April 3th 2022. The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- the ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

- each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name of the competitor; Example:
 - FS_Category_Competitor full name_short/free (FS_Cubs_Kovács Éva_short)
- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program, in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee
