Location of the competition: Ifj. Ocskay Gábor Ice Hall of Székesfehérvár (indoor arena: 30m x 60m) 8000 Székesfehérvár, Raktár utca 1.

Date of the competition: 9-10th April, 2022.

Objective of the competition: Providing the senior, junior, youngsters, recreational skater with the opportunity to compete.

Entries: All ISU members and clubs, members of National Figure Skating Federations associated in I.S.U., are invited to take part at the competition. Entry Forms should be used!

Entries must be done with the attached Entry Forms. The entry forms, the “Program Content Sheet” must be returned to the Organizing Committee in time. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each Skater in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Deadline for entries: The entries (competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches, other persons) must reach the organizer by

18th March, 2022.

Entry fee:

HUF 20.000 /person — Competitor with one program

HUF 25.000 /person — Competitor with two program

Late entry fee:

HUF 25.000 /person — Competitor with one program

HUF 30.000 /person — Competitor with two program

Deadline for entry fee: 18th March 2022.



Only on-site payment available.

You can only pay the entry fees together with the registration on the spot.

Other costs: accomodation, travel and meals are organized and borne independently by the participating Member Organization.

Reward:

Medals for the first three places in every age group, diplomas and presents for all participants.

Schedule:

The schedule of the competition will be compiled and announced after the entry deadline based on the entries received.

Technical and Judicial Panels:

The technical panel and judges are appointed by the MOKSZ Judging Committee in consultation with sectoral sports director.

Draw:

The draw will be in the days before the race, the running order of the competitors will be drawn by electronic lottery. The free skating programs are run in reverse order by the competitors

Program components:

PPCs for the Senior, Junior, Novice categories must be submitted by e-mail with the English abbreviations specified in the ISU Communication, together with the entry of the competition in the order of their respective presentation.

Everyone participates in the competition at their own risk and insurance, the organizer of the competition does not take any responsibility for any accident or injuries.

Together with the entry, the competitor acknowledges and agrees that a picture and sound recording will be made of it, the recorded recording can be used by the MOKSZ and the Székesfehérvári Jégmadár Figure Skating Club, which can appear in the materials prepared for the media about the competition. Together with the entry, the competitor expressly consents to the processing of his/her personal data required for entry by the Székesfehérvári Jégmadár Figure Skating Club.

The purpose of data management is to register in the competition system and to administrate the results achieved in the competition. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

LADIES

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.



JUNIOR CATEGORIES

MEN

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2021/22.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

LADIES

Short Program:

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2021/22.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating:

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

YOUNGER CATEGORIES

Cubs (age requirements) – Born after 1st July 2011 – before 30th June 2012

Mini Cubs (age requirements) – Born after 1st July 2012 – before 30th June 2013

Free Skating:

!!! Duration – Girls: 2 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

!!! Duration – Boys: 2 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

a) Maximum of 5 jump elements for Girls and Boys, and one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. A jump sequence can start any type of jumps, but it must be followed an Axel type jump. Jump combination can contain only two jumps. Only two jumps with 1, 1 ½, 2 or 2 ½. revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. Triple jumps are not permitted.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.

c) The sequence (step) will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

d) In case of fall the deduction will be -0,5 by the Technical Panel

The Program Components are only judged in:

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The factors for the Program Components: 2.5

Levels explanations:

The highest level that can be given for rotations and steps is Level 2. Other additions are not included in the level requirements and will not be considered by the Technical Panel.



CHICKS GIRLS & BOYS - SINGLE SKATING

Chicks (age requirements) - Born after 1st of July 2013 – before 30th of June 2014

Mini Chicks - Born after 30th of June 2014

Free Skating:

Duration – Girls: 2 min. +/- 10 sec.

Duration – Boys: 2 min. +/- 10 sec.

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, and one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. A jump sequence can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump can started any type of jumps, but it must be followed an Axel type jump. A jump combination can contain only two jumps. Only two jumps with 1, 1 ½, 2 or 2 ½ revolutions can be repeated either in the free skating program. Triple jumps are not permitted.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.

c) The Choreo Sequence must contain one spiral position with 3 sec. The choreo sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

d) In case of fall the deduction will be -0,5 by the Technical Panel

The Program Components are only judged in

- Skating Skills
- Performance/Execution

The Factor of the Program Components is 2.5.

Levels explanations: The highest level that can be given for rotations and steps is Level 2. Other additions are not included in the level requirements and will not be considered by the Technical Panel.
