THE VENUE

MAIN RINK

Sud de France Arena

Route de la Foire, 34470, Pérols



The biggest events of the moment bring you together in the exceptional Montpellier Arena. Since the 3rd of September 2010, concerts, sporting events, shows, exhibitions, festivals: all major events have been staged here and complement the excellent facilities to be found in other places in the town.

Remember that Montpellier gives pride of place to cultural and festive events, especially at the Zénith or the Corum. Over time, the Sud de France Arena has become part of the Montpellier landscape as the unmissable place to be in the region, and indeed in the South of France!

A stone's throw from Montpellier town centre, by tram or by car, you can easily reach the small town of Pérols in Hérault, where the impressive building stands. Easily accessible, the Sud de France Arena (formerly Park & Suites Arena) is one of the largest venues in France.

You cannot fail to notice that it is the twin sister of the Accor Hotels Arena in Paris. Designed by renowned architects, the auditorium is first and foremost functional and welcoming to be able to host a multitude of events that make up a varied and eclectic programme of events. The auditorium is multifunctional, its layout adapting to the demands of each type of event. It has a capacity of over 10,000 people when the event is a convention, while the capacity rises to 14,800 seats in a theatre format!

More than 13,500 m² can be used in exhibition format. Almost 10,700 places are available for sporting events.

The place has indeed headlined many major sporting events. For example, the Arena was proud to host basketball during the European Championships in 2015, but also horse riding, gymnastics and even handball, karate, tennis (l'Open Sud de France takes up residence there every winter) are not to be forgotten... In short, the auditorium is perfect for all big events.

Did you know it was the French group Indochine who inaugurated the auditorium?

The Sud de France Arena is the host of unforgettable concerts: Beyoncé, Bruce Springsteen, Rihanna, Muse, Les Enfoirés, Scorpions, Shakira, Katy Perry, Chris Brown, ... International sporting events: Gymnastics World Championship, the Euro Volleyball, Supercross ... Shows, congresses, conventions... Everything is designed to dazzle the eyes and ears in the best possible conditions! Practical: The comfort is complete with bars, eateries, lockers, air conditioning...



Access for people with disabilities:

People with reduced mobility who hold a disability card are invited to use the 2 crossing points reserved for them with their accompanying person(s) (Doors 1 and 8). Two elevators are at their disposal with direct access from the control points to access the fixed stands without difficulty and a special place in the arena will be reserved.

Transportation:

Easily accessible in public transport by the line 3 of the tramway which links the downtown of Montpellier, the train station, and the Arena, stop at "Parc Expo". Or by car, with the highway A709, exit 29 if you come from the North or East, or exit 30 if you come from the West.

PRACTICE RINK

Vegapolis

1 Place de la petite France, 34000, Montpellier



In the middle of one of the living centers of Montpellier with shopping centers, cinema, and restaurants, Vegapolis is the Ice Rink where Montpellier residents can learn and practice ice skating with a dedicated youth program reaching around 50 000 children each year.

With an Olympic 60x30 meters ice rink, 1 200 seats, adding to multiple spaces for locker rooms, meeting, and a playful track of 1 300 m² of ice: Végapolis is France's leading recreational skating rink in terms of attendance, attracting nearly 300,000 people yearly.

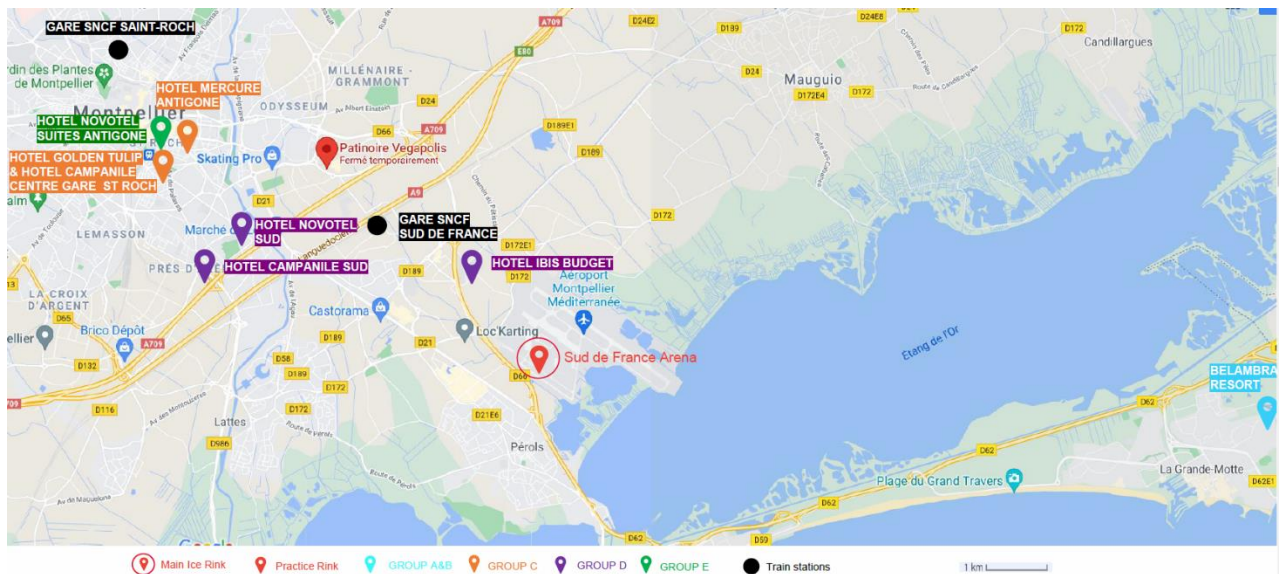
Transportation:

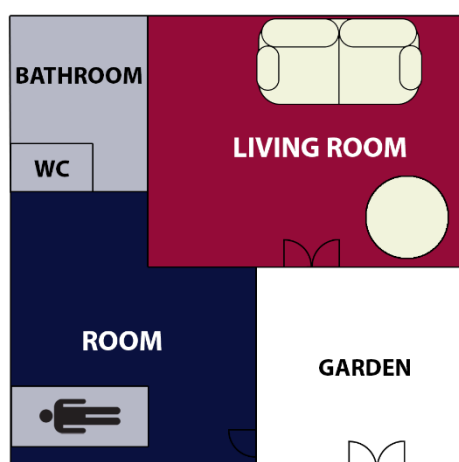

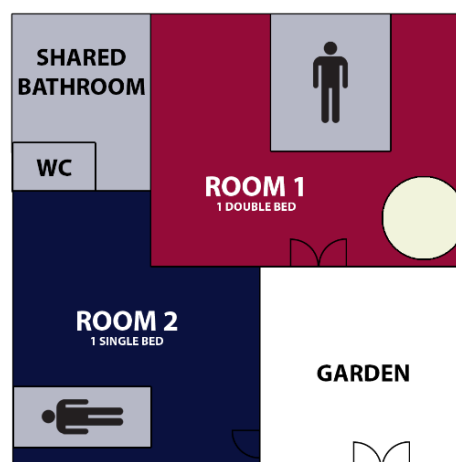

WHILE IN MONTPELLIER : PLACES TO VISIT AND THINGS TO DO

Enjoy a drink on the famous place de la Comédie

Located in the heart of Montpellier, the Place de la Comédie is THE place to be ! Formerly known as the "egg" (Place de l'œuf) due to its oval shape, and dominated by the Comédie opera house, this is one of Europe's most extensive pedestrian areas. In the centre of the square, the "3 Graces" fountain, created in 1773, reigns supreme. A great place to soak up the city's vibes !

A carefree experience

A pedestrian-friendly destination, enjoy discovering Montpellier on foot, bicycle or tram. Leave stress and noise behind. Here, cars are not welcome in the city-centre. Upon arrival at St Roch station, visitors are immediately immersed in a vast pedestrian area. The thrill of discovery is all the more intense, with street artists and buzzing café terraces from which to watch the permanent ballet of the 4 colourful tram lines serving the city.

Take a deep breath of fresh art

A preference for fine art or contemporary art ? Not to be missed : the Fabre Museum, considered as one of Europe's most beautiful Fine Arts museums, with European works from the Renaissance to the present day, and a full wing dedicated to contemporary artist, Pierre Soulages. And the MOCO, a brand-new contemporary art centre that opened its doors in June 2019, showing temporary exhibitions from international collectors.

Lovers of urban culture must not miss the Halle Tropisme, newly installed in the Creative City which has taken up residence in a series of former army warehouses.

Strolling in medieval streets

The ancient city-centre of Montpellier is packed with winding, medieval streets, a symbol of its proud past. Rue de la Valfère, rue du Bras de Fer, rue de la Argenterie all offer visitors a taste of bygone times.

The very best way to discover them ? Leave the map behind, and just enjoy discovering the aura of these narrow streets. On the agenda, a fun shopping spree in boutiques with vaulted ceilings, which alone are worth the visit and a trip back in time, where designers, antique dealers, tea rooms and galleries abound !

Take in the surrounding countryside

Montpellier Méditerranée offers a kaleidoscope of colours and atmospheres. The landscape around the central city of Montpellier is a genuine ode to nature : vineyards, hiking trails, sandy beaches, the nearby Pic Saint Loup, all less than an hour

away, along with picturesque Languedoc villages... The best place to discover the panorama of landscapes ? From the top of the triumphal arch or water tower.

Getting away from it all on an architectural journey

Visitors to Montpellier are immediately struck by its vibrant diversity. Each district of the city is unique and distinct, illustrating the city's 1,000-year-old history. A clever mix of ancient and contemporary architecture, from medieval alleys to architectural masterpieces by top international architects, including Jean Nouvel, Zaha Hadid, Massimiliano Fuksas, and many more ! Starck's latest creation is also a must-see : Le Nuage, also l'Arbre Blanc by Sou Fujimoto or the Folie Divine by London architect, Farshid Moussavi.

Good vibes

Throughout the year, anytime, anywhere ! Vibrant, effervescent, the heart of Montpellier Méditerranée beats to the rhythm of its major events : Montpellier International Dance Festival, Radio France Festival, the International Extreme Sports Festival, sports competitions with French and international elite teams... But also an ode to tradition with the bull sports trophy, the sea festival and so much more... Choose a visit-event combo, the very best way to experience and share the delights of Montpellier Méditerranée !

Let your test buds do the walking

A visit to Montpellier Méditerranée is not complete without a tasty gourmet break ! Not to be missed ? A tasting-producer discovery combo : local wines direct from neighbouring vineyards, oysters straight from the Thau lagoon just 20 minutes from Montpellier, olives and oils from their producers...

But also, directly from the shopkeepers in the culinary markets of Laissac, Castellane, in the heart of the city, Jacques Cœur and Marché du Lez on the outskirts... Without forgetting, the Estivales summer festival, organized in many local towns and villages, for fun, gourmet festivity !

Take a stroll, night and day

Hop on line 4 of the tramway to visit the city centre and discover some of Montpellier's most beautiful heritage jewels : Place Royale du Peyrou, Faculty of Medicine, the monumental towers (Tour des Pins, Tour de la Babote)... Our special favourite ? Visit the city at nightfall, and discover all these treasures beautifully lit up !

Take a cycle trip to the sea all year round, and enjoy the private beaches on sunny days

With the Mediterranean just 11km away, the seaside is an integral part of the Montpellier experience. Enjoy an invigorating getaway to Villeneuve les Maguelone... not to be missed ! Discover Maguelone cathedral, a Romanesque jewel in an enchanting setting between vineyards and the sea. A tip ? Take a bike ride out to the beach, through the Port Marianne district, then along the fully-secured Mediterranean trail... Enjoy feeling the wind in your hair !

TRAVEL INFORMATION

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation for arrivals and departures from the Airport "Montpellier-Méditerranée" (MPL) and the train station "Montpellier St-Roch".

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

All ISU officials, judges and team members are picked up at the official airport and train station in accordance with the submitted arrival schedule, and necessary ground transportation will be organized to the Official Hotels.

Coaches, team medical staff, and member press officers, who do not arrive with the teams will be charged 50€ as ground transportation fee. This fee can be either pay by their respective delegation or by the person himself.

Please provide the OC with the appropriate travel details in ORS. Once you have arrived and received your baggage, look for the OC Representative who will welcome you and direct you to the appropriate transportation. If your flight is delayed or cancelled, please inform your expected arrival time as soon as possible to the OC, by contacting the OC at montpellier2022@ffsg.org

There are several airport transportations available for anyone who has not informed the OC of their arrival information or those arriving prior to the date indicated for the start of the airport shuttle service. If a guest chooses one of these methods of transportation to the hotel, the OC is not responsible for the costs.

EVENT SHUTTLES

A shuttle bus service will run between the main rink (Sud de France Arena) and the practice rink (Vegapolis) and these hotels:

- Belambra Resort
- Golden Tulip
- Campanile Centre Gare St-Roch
- Mercure Montpellier Centre Antigone

The shuttle bus service will start on Monday, March 21, 2021 and run until Sunday, March 27, 2021, departing every 30 minutes. A detailed schedule will be available at Accreditation and on the ISU App.

VISA APPLICATION

The Government of France requires that all travellers carry a valid passport as the only universally accepted travel and identification document for the purposes of international travel if you are from outside the European Union. If you are from the European Union, the ID card can be used for traveling.

Processing for visa application vary depending on the visa and the time of the year. Participants are encouraged to apply approximately **12 weeks** in advance of their departure date to ensure they receive the visa in time.

REGISTRATION & ACCREDITATION



A total of 3 accreditation centers will be available: one in the Competitors Hotel, one at the ISU Hotel and one at the venue.

Accreditations for the Teams will be issued at the Belambra Resorts. The accreditation room "Camargue" will be opened from 15:00, Saturday, March 19, 2022 (TBC) until Saturday March 26. The exact hours will be communicated later on.

Accreditations for the Event Officials, ISU, Judges and IMG will be issued at the Golden Tulip. The accreditation room "Saphir + Topaze" will be opened from 15:00, Saturday, March 19, 2022 (TBC) until Wednesday, March 23, 2022 (evening). Then from Thursday, March 24 to Sunday March 27 accreditation will take place in the OC Office at the Hotel. The exact hours will be communicated later on.

Accreditations for the rest of the participants (mainly Media, TV and Volunteers) will be issued at the Sud de France Arena, next to the ticket booth at the main spectator entrance. The accreditation room will be opened from Saturday, March 19, 2022 to Sunday, March 27, 2022 permanently.

For Media they will be issued at the Media Center.

No accreditation will be issued without presentation of a valid travel ID (passport or Schengen ID).

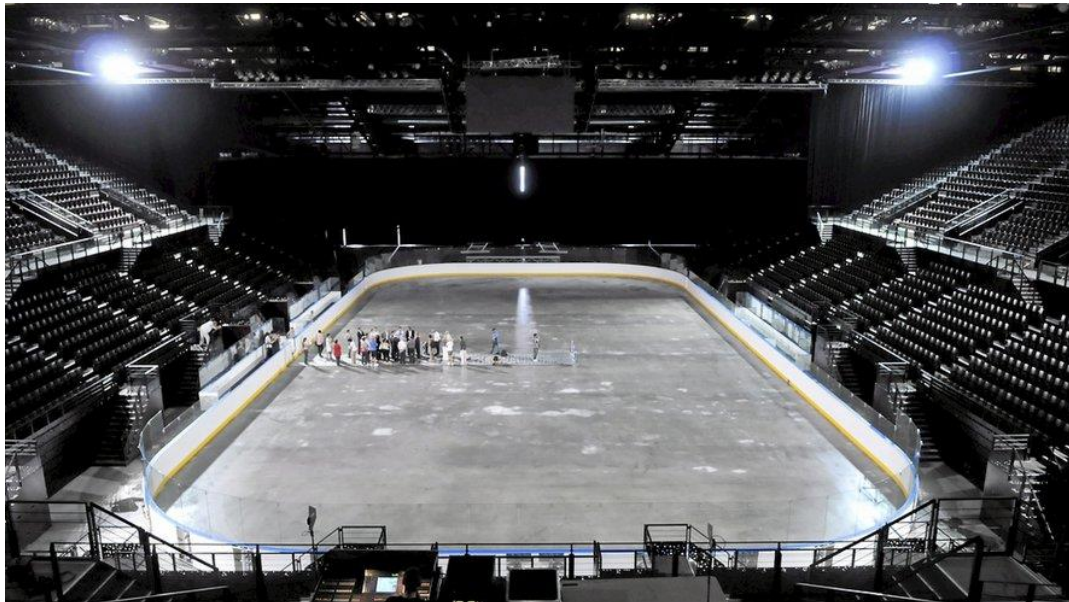
Lost Accreditation Cards

SUSTAINABILITY

The Organizing Committee, with the ISU World Figure Skating Championships® 2022, is actively striving to put sustainability at its rightful and important place in the world.

With this purpose, The French Federation of Ice Sports will soon sign the Ministry of Sports' sustainability charter for the organization of major international events with concrete actions:

Commitment 1

Appointment of a "sustainability development" referent in the organization which will work on solutions for the event and will report to the general management.

Commitment 2

Provide a healthy and diversified food offer with a choice of organic and local products in catering.

Commitment 3

Reduce, sort and recycle all forms of waste and specifically decrease the use of single-use plastic by installing water fountains and other sustainable solutions.

Commitment 4

Promote travel in "clean" vehicles and in group to avoid private transportation.

Commitment 5

Sites dedicated to the public will be accessible to people with disabilities.

Commitment 6

Offer eco-responsible gifts and donate non-given gifts as well as stuffed animals (if allowed and collected) to hospitals. Recovery of used materials with an agreement with associations.

Commitment 7

Value the involvement and significant role of volunteers with a reward which can take different forms depending on their function and availability.

Commitment 8

Communicate and raise awareness of eco-responsibility aimed at target audiences (spectators, viewers, participants: athletes, volunteers, organizing teams and collaborators) and promote the eco-responsible behaviour of the event on-site.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Language

French is the official language, English is often used within the government services and structures that welcomes tourists (hotels, restaurants, museum, etc.).

The Climate

In March, the average temperature in Montpellier is 13 ° (the maximum temperature is 15 ° and the minimum temperature is 10 °).

The climate is quite fresh in this city, but it is pleasant when dressed warmly. With 95mm over 7 days, you risk getting wet slightly during your trip, but the sunny days will definitely put a smile on your face.

Currency

The official domestic currency is the Euro (€).

Banking Hours

Most bank are open Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 18:00. Most of them are closed during the weekends but some are open for a short amount of time on Saturday morning.

Money exchange

Foreign currency can be exchange at the airport, banks and exchange offices.

Emergency Services

Use these emergency numbers to get through to the emergency services free of charge, 24/7.

15 = SAMU: The French Emergency Medical Assistance Service. To call out a medical team to a medical emergency as well as to be referred to a round-the-clock health facility.

COVID-19

With the current COVID-19 pandemic across the world, the ISU and Organizing Committee are prioritizing the health and safety of each event attendees by putting in place guidelines and measures in order to organizing safe events.

Therefore, we kindly ask you to make sure to carefully read the ISU General Guidelines which describe the minimum sanitary measures that will be put in place for the ISU Events during the COVID-19 pandemic and which will be applied during the ISU Figure Skating World Championships 2022 in Montpellier.

Additionally, you will find below the specific regulations of the French government.

Entry regulations

The rules for travel to and from France depend on the country from which or to which the person wish to travel, the reason for which the person is travelling and its vaccination status.

However, the current regulations are subject to change as we are delighted to observe an improvement in the sanitary situation which will hopefully keep on getting better until March 2022.

Therefore, we will do our very best with our government to avoid any restrictive measures and every ISU Member will receive updates on the situation closer to the event.

Attending the event: Health Pass - “Pass Sanitaire”

Capacity limits have been lifted for all events and venues. For public events bringing together over 50 people, spectators aged 11 and over will need to present a health pass.

The pass must prove one of the three following items:

1. That you are fully vaccinated (with an EMA-approved vaccine or similar):
 - Seven days after the second shot for two-shot vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca);
 - Four weeks after the shot for one-shot vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);
 - Seven days after the shot for vaccines administered to people who have already had COVID-19 (only one dose is necessary).
2. OR that you have been tested (PCR or antigen) with a negative result within the last 48hrs;

3. OR that you have recovered from COVID-19, attested by a positive PCR or antigen test result, at least 15 days and no more than 6 months old.

Passes can be digital (on the "TousAntiCovid" app) or in paper form (proof of vaccination or test result). They must be presented in English or French. They include a QR code that will be scanned on entry into the venue or event.

The French health pass is interoperable with the EU Digital COVID Certificate scheme for travel within the European Union, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Norway, San Marino, Switzerland and the Vatican.
