Technical regulations and conditions:

The Synchronized Skating Cup 2018 will be held according to the ISU General Regulations 2017, the Special Regulations Synchronized Skating 2017 as well as the valid Technical Rules and Conditions SYS of the Swiss Skating Union (SEV).

Important: The organiser advises the teams of the Non-ISU categories to refer to the special and adjusted Technical Conditions SYS (see **Technical Guidelines Swiss 2017/2018**).

Teams which have participated in the ongoing season in a certain category are not allowed to take part in another category at the Synchronized Skating Cup EVBN.

Judging system:

The ISU judging system will be used.

Music:

After final registration the music must be uploaded online (oneDrive). The respective link will be submitted accordingly to all registered teams. Teams are requested to bring their CDs as back-up, well marked with **name, club** and **programme** as well as the **name of composers** (for SUISA – financial reasons).

Ice rink:

The ice rink is not heated. Upon registrations the dressing rooms at the ice rink are occupied in a rotation principle. The schedules for the dressing rooms are listed on the detailed timetable (will follow by e-mail). We kindly ask the teams to leave their dressing rooms immediately after practice and competition.

Attention: All teams must take their baggage with them. Baggage cannot be left in the dressing rooms or at the ice rink!

The registration office is situated at the ice rink.

Tickets for the competition cost CHF 10.00 for adults and CHF 3.00 for children (6-15 years).

Warm-up area:

The warm-up area is located next to and linked to the ice rink in 3 gyms. The warm-up times follow a fixed distribution. The exact time schedules will be on the timetables following by e-mail. *Attention: It may happen, that two teams must share the warm-up area. We kindly ask these teams to be respectful for each other. Each team must bring its own music equipment.*

Registration:

The registration has two forms:

Entry form 1 for registration of the teams

Entry form 2 for the definite registration of the team members

All members of Swiss teams must show their licence. Skaters in non-Swiss teams will need to identify themselves by a copy of their passport or identity card when registering at the event.

Entry form 2 and the „**Program Content Sheet** (form 3)“ and the „**Music information form** (form 4)“ must be sent until **31st Dezember 2017** to: Either upload OneDrive or Mrs Claudia Scherrer, tk-sys@evbn.ch (final process will be confirmed)

Entry fee:

All categories: **CHF 390.00 per team.**

Entry fees will not be reimbursed and the registration is only valuable, if the entry fees are paid in full until 30th October 2017.

All skaters and clubs are personally responsible for their accommodation, meals and transportation. There is a possibility for lunch and dinner at the ice rink. The teams should order meal vouchers from the organiser (following by e-mail).

Liability: The organiser assumes no liability for possible accidents or other damages by competitors, coaches or officials.

Official practice:

The official practice will start on Saturday, 03rd February 2018. The official practice for each team lasts 10 minutes for the short programs Senior ISU and Junior ISU and the free programs Basic Novice, Juvenile and Adult. And 12 minutes for all other categories (free program). The official practice is mandatory for all teams.

Judges:

Judges with the qualification “National SYS Judge” or judges, who are on the official list of ISU for international competitions, can be proposed to the organiser. The announcement will take place by the federation. A judge can only be proposed if a minimum of two (2) teams from the judge’s country participate in the competition. The proposal (entry form J) must be sent **until 18th October 2017** to Mrs Claudia Scherrer (tk-sys@evbn.ch). Delayed proposals cannot be taken in consideration.

The organiser will cover board and lodging from Friday, 02nd to Sunday, 04th February 2018 if the arrival and departure is not possible on the day of the competition. The federation or the judge must pay all additional fees.

Doping control:

It is possible that a doping control will take place.

Accommodation/Transportation:

The Sport Centre Huttwil offers suitable accommodation directly at the ice rink for teams. The teams are requested to contact Campusperspektiven directly, www.campusperspektiven.ch. All skaters and clubs are directly responsible for their own accommodation, meals and transportation.
