Must be submitted by email using the abbreviations specified in the communication, in the order of presentation, together with the competition entry.

Awards

The team finishing in first place will be awarded a trophy. Medals will be given to all podium finishers, and every skater will receive a certificate of participation.



General Rules

The Skate Hungary 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating as well as relevant ISU Communications for Season 2025/2026. All teams and competitors must belong to an ISU Member and qualify regarding eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in the ISU Rules and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

Categories

- **Senior** At least age of 17 before July 1, 2025. The Team shall consist of 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates. Short Program: maximum 2 minutes 50 seconds, Factor 1,33 Free Skating Program: 4 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Senior Short Program and Senior Free Skating. If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during Competition, the Team will be permitted to skate with not less than 14 Skaters.
- **Junior** At least age of 13 but have not reached the age of 19 before July 1, 2025. A Team shall consist of twelve to sixteen Skaters – according to the rule 800 in the 2024 Special Regulations and Technical Rules. Short Program: maximum 2 minutes 50 seconds, Factor 1,33 Free Skating Program: 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Junior Short Program and Junior Free Skating.
- **Advanced Novice** Shall consist 12-16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates. At least the age of 10 but not reached the age of 16 before July 2025. Free Skating program 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec). Factor 2,67 Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Advanced Novice Free Skating.
- **Basic Novice** The skaters must have reached the age of 10 but have not reached the age of 16 by July 1, 2025. The Team shall consist of 12 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates. Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67, Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Basic novice free program. The highest difficulty Group of an Additional Feature may be attempted and will be called as executed. At Synchronized Spin level 1 is the max call, according to the Well Balanced Program.



• **Juvenile**

The skaters must have not reached the age of 13 by July 1, 2025.

The Team shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Basic Novice free program

The highest level of elements can be skated, but only a maximum of level 3 will be called.

Maximum of SySp Level 1 will be called.

• **Pre-Juvenile**

The skaters must have not reached the age of 11 by July 1, 2025.

The Team shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Basic Novice

The highest level of elements can be skated, but only a maximum of level 2 will be called.

Maximum of SySp Level 1 will be called.

• **Mixed Age**

The Team shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters, there are no age limits.

Free Skating Program: 3,30 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67,

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Mixed Age

Max call: maximum element levels 3. The highest difficulty Group of an Additional Feature may be attempted and will be called as executed. Follows the General rules for the Junior category. Illegal Elements are following the restriction of Rule 992 para 2. c)

Deductions will be in accordance with Rule 843 para 1. m)

• **Adult**

The skaters must have reached the age of 18 by July 1 the year preceding the competition, a minimum of 50 % of the skaters must be over 23.

The Team Shall consist of 8 to 20 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 1,67

Well Balanced Program Content and other rules will be according to the ISU Technical Requirements for International Adult Figure Skating Competitions 2025-26 for adult teams.

Max call: maximum element levels and the highest difficulty Group of an Additional Feature may be attempted and will be called as executed.

Age rules for Interclub categories

75% of the skaters performing the program have to be in the correct age of the category, 25% can be out of the age limit. For the other 25% a permissible age deviation of +/-2 years is permitted for Mini, Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile and Non ISU Basic Novice, a permissible age deviation of -3 years is permitted for Adult. This exception applies to the competition team. In a team of 20, a maximum of 4 skaters can be younger or older. In the spirit of fair play, please note: If you have a team of e.g. 16 skaters and you skate your free skating e.g. with 12 skaters, you can only have 3 skaters that don't meet the age criteria (younger or older) on the competing teams. 50% of the skaters can be overlapped if you have more teams competing.

By submitting an entry, the competitor explicitly consents to the processing of the personal data necessary for the registration by BudaSkate SE and Skate Hungary. The purpose of data processing is registration in the competition system and the administration of results achieved during the competition. The data provided with the entry will be managed by BudaSkate SE and Skate Hungary in accordance with applicable laws, in particular GDPR provisions, and may be transferred to the Hungarian National Skating Federation (HNSF) for information and statistical purposes. BudaSkate SE does not use a data processor. Skate Hungary will provide on-site medical care (first aid) during the competition. The organizer reserves the right to change the venue, the date/time, and the program.
