GENERAL: Triglav Trophy 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024/2025, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications. Participation in the Triglav Trophy 2026 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of it.

EUROPEAN CRITERIUM TROPHY: Triglav Trophy 2026 is associated with the European Criterium Tournament 2025/26 for Junior, Novice, Cubs and Chicks categories. Results of the Teams will count for competition of International Trophy of Figure Skating European Criterium. Individual points are automatically calculated for all skaters in every category and those are valid in the European Criterium Tournament in the same category. The age requirements and the special regulation for the European Criterium Trophy are published on the website of the EC: www.europeancriterium.eu and ISU: www.isu.org/figure-skating/figure-skating-events/figure-skating-calendar.

ENTERING THE COMPETITION

Competitors in Junior and Senior categories (International competition) must be entered through their ISU Members.

If there are too many entries registered in an individual category and the competition can not be held according to the published preliminary schedule, the organizer may limit the number of competitors in the free skating up to 30 for Juniors.

Competitors taking part in International competition must be registered through their respective ISU Member Federations on ISU ORS registration system: <https://fsk-ors.isu.swisstiming.com>

The number of registered competitors is not limited. After the ISU Member receives confirmation of the entries from the ORS system, then they login a maximum of two competitors per category on the European Criterium entry system with music, or/ and they forward the received confirmations from the ORS to their interested clubs, who can then login a maximum of two competitors per category with music on the European Criterium entry system.

Each participant must send to the web administrator (<http://www.europeancriterium.eu>) request for code direct online registration and realize the entry not later (deadline for entries) than March 17th 2026. The entries for the competition will be held via web portal www.europeancriterium.eu. Before entry procedure association/ club representative need to apply for new account on www.europeancriterium.eu/Account/Register.

Organizer reserves the right to make exceptions and to accept additional entries. Each competitor registrant must confirm that the competitor has been confirmed through the ORS system. Organizers of the European Criterium website are committed to the proper protection of personal data in accordance with the European Union GDPR regulation. Therefore, in the

context of Privacy Policy, is require appropriate consent in the applications. Without this, the entries for European Criterium competitions can not possible in the future.

The "Program Content Sheet" for all categories must be returned to the Organizing Committee not later than March 17th 2026. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet will be filled precisely by each Skater in English using terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

MUSIC

After confirming and sending new registration data of selected competitors it is mandatory to add files with music the competitors need for their performances.

The process anticipates that competitor's application is in the pending status first. After confirming there is an option to attach the appropriate music file to competitor's application.

When the file is attached to application the status of competitor's application goes to active status and the competitor is included in the official competitors list of selected competition.

Mandatory music format is .mp3 file format. Files must be labelled with the name of the category, segment, name(s) of the competitor(s) and ISU Member abbreviation.

Applicants (representative of club or national skating association) is given the option to replace the files with music three day before the competition starts.

Junior and Senior Categories have to attach two music files for valid active status of competitor's application (Short program and Free Skating program).

Organizers of competitions can download a music file of selected competitor and download a full package of files ordered and grouped by the categories. Competitors must have copy of their's mp3 files on USB key (or any external USB drive).

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES:

All entries (for both competitions) – competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches, other participants are expected not later than March 17th 2026.

Entry fee for competition

Entry fee is 100 EUR per skater for the categories Junior, Senior.

Upon prior agreement, the entry fee can be paid in cash on the day of the competition, in the amount of 110 EUR. In case of paying entry fee in cash it is mandatory to make an advance notice about it on e-mail: dkjesenice@gmail.com, with full name of competitor and name of the category of competitor.

Charges:

For successful application, starting fee has to be paid until close of Entries (March 29th) 2026.

Important note: Please include the competitor's name in the payment reference so that we can confirm the payment and include competitor in the entries.

The participants are kindly asked to inform the Organizer about all the payments with e-mail note. Please define the names of the participants, categories and all the other payments for each participant. We kindly ask you to submit payment confirmation at the accreditation.

Cancellation:

Cancellation of the competitor entry, if any, has to be done till April 2nd 2026 with e-mail to organizer. For any later cancellation the team leader or any representative of Club will be asked to pay the entry fee.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason after the cancellation date.

Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure:

In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. The local organizing committee has the right and obligation to check the personal identification documents of the athletes to determine whether they are allowed to compete, whether they are competing in the right category, etc. Without the documents, the athlete will be excluded from the competition.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR WOMEN & MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules, Single and Pair Skating 2024 and respective ISU Communications.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS

All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System.

DRAW

Draw for all categories will be performed in the presence of the Referee and Technical Controller in accordance with Rules 512 and 513 at 14:00 hour, Thursday 10th April 2026. Starting order for the free skating of categories Juniors and Seniors will be in reverse order of the results of the short program.

JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Panel of Judges and Technical Panel will be formed by the organizing committee and will include judges from the participating countries on the Competition. Panel of Judges for category Cubs and Chicks will be composed of at least three judges from three different nations.

Panel of Judges for Novice, Junior and Senior will be composed as determined by the relevant ISU Communications.

LIABILITY: In accordance with the ISU Regulations, Rule 119 the Organizer accept no liability for the damage or injuries which any of participants, judges, officials or others may suffer.

AWARDING: Skaters placed first to third will be awarded medals and diplomas, all the others diplomas, after each event.

Final awarding: At the last event of the European Criterium series the individual winners of the final ranking of each category and the best participants will get a trophy. At least three complete competitions in one season are required to be awarded trophy.

EXPENSES

Organizer covers the accommodation expenses with full board and travel expenses only for the confirmed Referees, Judges, nominated Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators in the Hotel HIT Alpinea in Kranjska Gora, from dinner on April 8th, until breakfast on April 13th. Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Club via E-mail. The transport from the hotel to the ice rink and back will be provide. Expenses for accommodation and meals for Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the organizer.

Hotel Information: The organizer will provide special rates for all of the participants staying in one of the hotels of HIT Alpinea in Kranjska Gora:

- 100 EUR per person daily: full board accommodation in a single room;
- 85 EUR per person daily: full board accommodation in a double room;
- 80 EUR per person daily: full board accommodation in a triple room;
- 94 EUR per person daily: half board accommodation in a single room;
- 75 EUR per person daily: half board accommodation in a double room;
- 70 EUR per person daily: half board accommodation in a triple room;
- 87 EUR per person daily: room-breakfast accommodation in a single room;
- 65 EUR per person daily: room-breakfast accommodation in a double room;
- 60 EUR per person daily: room-breakfast accommodation in a triple room.

Please note, that accommodation fees have to be payed directly in the official hotel.
