GENERAL REGULATIONS:

Olympic Autumn Cup 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations for Figure Skating as well as all pertinent ISU Communications for Figure Skating and the classification of the Estonian Skating Union for season 2026/2027.

Participation in the Olympic Autumn Cup 2026 is open only to competitors and clubs who belong to an ISU Member. All invited clubs, ISU-Members or Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class.

The results for Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to latest ISU regulations. All other categories and beginners will be calculated according to the Estonian Figure Skating Union Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2026/2027.

In case of force majeure circumstances, which are beyond the control of the organizer, such as epidemiological situation, war, military operations or political situation or other circumstances, the organizer is entitled to cancel or postpone the event without having any related penalties. In case of circumstances, which are beyond the control of the organizer, the organizer has the right to change the venue of the competition without having any related penalties.

Artistic Skating:

Artistic Kids Free Skating : no judging, all the skaters get 1st place

Artistic Adults Free Skating : no judging, all the skaters get 1st place

RESULTS:

- The results for Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to ISU judging system using the judging panel of 5 judges in case of Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior and the judging panel of 3 judges in case of Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice.

- Pre-Chicks – Cubs will be calculated according to Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2026/2027 using judging panel of 3 judges.

- All B class categories will be calculated according to Classification for B class for season 2026/2027 using a judging panel of 3 judges.

- All Beginners categories will be calculated according to Classification for Beginners for season 2026/2027 using a judging panel of 3 judges.

The organizer has the right to split categories if the number of participants requires that.

The organizer has the right to combine categories if the number of participants requires.

REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

Each **club** has the right to enter competitors in any category and class.

Entry forms must be submitted by **September 8th, 2026**. **Entries must be submitted through the Sportity app.**

ENTRY FEE (paid before September 10th, 2026):

Single Skating with one program: 90€

Single Skating with two programs: 110€

Pair Skating with two programs: 110€

Artistic Free Skating: 60€

LATE ENTRY FEE (all entries paid after September 10th, 2026 are declared to be late entry) All Entry Fee payments received after September 10th, 2026 are subject to a late entry fee of 10€ per single skater/couple.

Each club has to pay **100%** of the total amount for its participants **right after the entry form confirmation**, but not later than **September 10th, 2026**.

The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment may only be replaced by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs. The OC reserves the right to cancel the Entry of skaters whose entry fee has not been paid by the published deadline

We kindly ask the clubs to make one payment for all its participants.

- All registration-related procedures (annulment, changes) must be submitted to the organizer in written form as soon as possible, but no later than **September 30, 2026** to the e-mail: olympicfsc@gmail.com
- In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but can not participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the organizer has to reduce the entries.

AWARDING:

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a cup. All competitors will receive a diploma and a gift.

ACCOMMODATION:

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves.

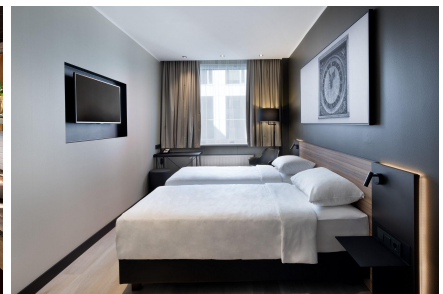

All skaters, coaches, judges and team leaders must comply with ISU Communication No. 1433 (Code of Ethics). Any violation may result in disciplinary action, including disqualification.

An electronic draw will take place on 01.10.2026.

For the Free Skating the starting order will be the reverse order of the result after the Short Program.

Preliminary time schedule will be published after the deadline for entries and it will be available.
